NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 This event is governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as changed by this notice of race, the sailing instructions, the prescriptions of US Sailing or the rules of the International 505 Class. The 505 Fleet 15 also reserves the right to change this notice of race.

1.2 All CDC, State of Florida, County and City of Clearwater guidelines/restrictions will be strictly followed along with the CCSC COVID-19 rules and regulations.

1.3 On February 18th, we will have a Go / No Go decision based on two factors: Covid-19 situation, and a minimum of 10 boats registered by that date.

1.4 DUE TO COVID-19, THIS EVENT MAY BE CANCELLED AT ANY TIME. If cancellation becomes necessary, entry fee will be refunded.

1.5 All persons on CCSC property shall wear a mask/face covering at all times while on site. This includes the parking lot, breezeways, classrooms, restrooms, and docks.

1.6 Temperature checks may be performed on all persons entering any CCSC facility.

1.7 It is critical to be mindful of how you feel, and particularly when ANY of the potential COVID-19 symptoms are present, to please stay home.

2. Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is restricted to members of the International 505 Class.

3. Fees

3.1 The entry fee is \$100USD if paid by February 18th, 2021

3.2 A late fee of \$10 (\$110 total) shall be paid for registrations completed after February 18th.

The courses will be windward leeward, with finishes to leeward. Final details will be in the sailing Instructions.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at CCSC Thursday, February 25th, and a digital version should be made available.

7 .Venue

The racing area will be on the Gulf of Mexico, directly south west of Clearwater Pass.

8. Advertising

This event will be governed by the World Sailing Regulation 20.

9. Scoring

The Low Point Score System of RRS, Appendix A will apply.

10. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the drivers and crews placing first through third. The winning team will also be loaned the Midwinter Championship perpetual trophy. Their names will be etched on the trophy.

11. Disclaimer

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization, nor the sponsors will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
