NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 This regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the US Sailing Prescriptions except when noted herein and in the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 RRS 40.1 shall be in effect for the entirety of this regatta

1.3 Class Rules of the various catamaran classes eligible to compete.

2. Advertising

2.1 Advertising is permitted as per class rules

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 Catamaran classes: A Cat, Hobie Wave, Hobie 14, 16, 17, 18, 20, Mystere, Nacra and any other catamaran with a US Sailing Portsmouth Number

3.2 Eligible boats may register by completing the entry form via Regatta Network at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21643>

4. Fees

4.1 The entry fee for single-handed boats shall be \$40, double-handed boats \$65, which includes Saturday night dinner and weekend beverages.

4.2 Additional social/meal tickets may be purchased at registration. Adults \$15, Children under 12 \$5

5. Schedule

5.1 Registration Friday, 20 May, 0900-1000 hrs.

5.2 Competitors Meeting, Friday 20 May 1030 hrs.

5.3 There are no maximum number of races scheduled. As many races as weather and schedule may allow will be attempted.

5.4 Friday 21 May, 1st Warning 1130 hrs., other races to follow

5.5 Saturday 22 May, 1st Warning 1100 hrs., other races to follow

5.6 Saturday 22 May, dinner after racing

5.7 Sunday 23 May, 1st Warning 1000 hrs., other races to follow, no warning after 1430 hrs.

5.8 Sunday 23 May, Awards as soon as possible after racing

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 Sailing Instructions may be available on line before the regatta at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21643#_docs

6.2 Sailing Instructions shall be available at registration

7. Penalty System

7.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that only One-Turn is required for breaking one or more rules of Part 2.

8. Courses

8.1 Courses shall be Windward/Leeward with a downwind finish.

9. Scoring

9.1 The RRS Appendix A, Low Point Scoring shall apply

9.2 When fewer than six (6) races are completed, a boat's series shall be the total of all her finishes.

9.3 When six (6) or more races are completed, a boat's series shall be the total of all her finishes except her worst finish. This changes RRS A2.1

10. Electronic Communications

10.1 Use of hand-held VHF radio is allowed. The Race Committee will broadcast on channel 72.

10.2 No boat shall make or receive electronic communications that are not readily available to all competitors.

11. Insurance

11.1 Each participating boat shall provide proof of current third party insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000.

12. Prizes

12.1 Prizes shall be awarded three (3) deep in each class

13. Disclaimer of Liability

13.1 Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. RRS 4. Decision to Race.

13.2 The organizing authority for this regatta will not accept liability, material damage, or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.

14. Accommodations

14. On site free tent camping in designated area, hot showers, rest rooms. Motor homes will need to stay in the campground just up the street. Cabins available from the Hazlet Park district.
