1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, *Pensacola Bay General Sailing Instructions*, and Supplemental Sailing Instructions as applicable to this regatta.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker classes will be sailed under GYA PHRF handicapping.2.2 PHRF entries must have a valid PHRF Rating Certificate or accept a temporary, provisional rating assigned by the Race Committee.

2.3 To be scored in the Maxine Series, skippers must meet the eligibility requirements described in the attached "CONDITIONS FOR THE PENSACOLA BAY MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES."

3. FEES

Entry fee will be \$35.00 with proof that the skipper has a current US Sailing membership card and \$40.00 for non-US Sailing members.

4. NUMBER OF RACES

Two races are scheduled for both Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. The races will be sailed under the current Pensacola Bay General Sailing Instructions (PBGSI), except as modified by the Supplemental Sailing Instructions (SSI). Should there be a conflict between the NOR, PBGSI and SSI, the SSI will take precedence.

6.2. This NOR, PBGSI, and SSI are available online at NYCP website and Regatta Network race webpage.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1, Taking a Penalty, will apply.

8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward (L) using dropped marks for the Spinnaker classes. Non-Spinnaker classes will sail government marks courses.

9. SCORING

9.1 The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A4, will apply for the Commodore's Cup #1.

9.2 The High Point Scoring System will apply for the Commodore's Cup Series.

10. PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be given for this regatta as follows:

Spinnaker Divisions: $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place.

Non-Spinnaker Division: $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place.

10.2 Prizes will be awarded at the Crow's Nest, Bayou Grande Marina as soon as the racing results are final at approximately 1700.

CONDITIONS FOR THE PENSACOLA BAY MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES

- The MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY will be awarded for participation and performance on Pensacola Bay. The perpetual trophy will be held in trust at the Pensacola Yacht Club, engraved with the name of the winning yacht from each fleet. The individual yachts will receive personal trophies to commemorate their performance.
- 2) Races are to be sailed under the management of the race committee sponsoring each event. The series will be governed by the current International Racing Rules, the current prescriptions of USSA, and by the sailing instructions in force for each race for that race.
- 3) Each of the participation yacht clubs (PBYC, NYC, and PYC) will designate one race, open to other yacht club members to be hosted by that club during the year, to be scored for the yachts participating in the series. The designated races shall be selected and published prior to February 1st of each year. Should a race be canceled, a new race at that club will be designated as counting towards points for the series.
- 4) Skippers must be members in good standing of one of the participating yacht clubs for eligibility according to the requirements of the prior sentence. However, once a yacht is entered into the series, the skipper at that time will not be eligible to skipper another yacht for entry into or scoring for, the series. Entry into the MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES will be automatic upon entry into any of the individual designated races and the above eligibility requirements are met.
- 5) There will be two overall fleets in the series: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker. A Yacht may not enter the series in more than one fleet. The series scoring shall be in accordance to USSA Appendix A-Scoring. Rule A2 is modified so as no score is excluded. The individual yacht clubs shall provide the next club hosting a MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES race the official scoring results from that club's race, prior to the next race for the series. The official scoring should note those yachts not eligible for the series. The overall winning yacht for the series in each fleet will be determined after the results of the last race of the series, and shall be awarded trophies as described above.
