4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.2 The flagpole is located on the front lawn, easterly side, of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 MC Scow Class Flag will be the MC class insignia, or such flag as will be displayed at the competitors meeting.

7. COURSES

7.3 Courses will be either LA, WA, or LAD. This supplement describes course LAD, the order in which the marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.

8. MARKS

8.2

Mark	Description
1, 2s, 2p	Yellow inflatables
1a	Small ball
Start, Finish	Green inflatable
Change Mark	Orange inflatable

8.3 In the event of change of the windward mark, Mark 1a will not be relocated. Boats will round the new Mark 1 leaving it to port and shall disregard Mark 1a if it remains in the water.

8.4 If only one gate mark is set, boats shall leave the single mark to port.

12. TIME LIMITS

- 12.5 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after the starting signal will be scored Did Not Start, without a hearing. This changes RRS 5.1 and A5.2.

14. SAFETY

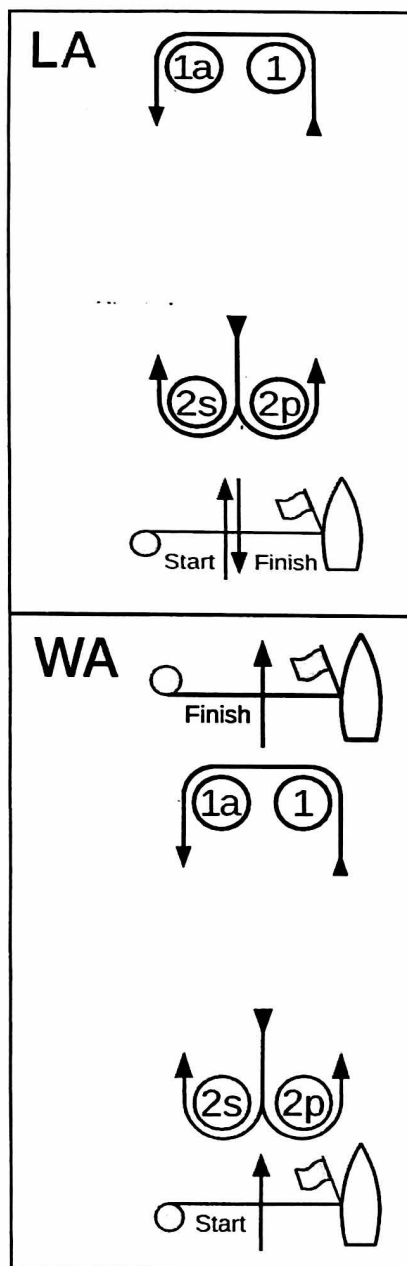
- 14.1 [DP] Boats shall check in with the race committee prior to their first race of the day. [DP]
- 14.2 [DP] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible. [DP]

- 16.1 The applicable VHF channel for this course is 72.


