AYC and CIYC are teaming up to bring you both on the same day!*

- 1 RULES:** This race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Any changes to the *rules* allowed by *rule 86* will be stated in the Sailing Instructions with the *rule* number and specific change.

In light of the current pandemic surge, racers are expected to follow state and local guidelines in effect at the time of the race to prevent its spread (eg, 6ft between non-household members, face coverings when less than 6ft apart, gloves, hand-washing, sanitizing).

**FLEETS & CLASSES:** The Regatta and Random-Leg Fleets are open to Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker classes. To facilitate social distancing, double- and single-handed entries are strongly encouraged. For larger crews, the recommended maximum total number of persons aboard is as follows:

<u>LOA</u>	<u>Maximum Crew (skipper and crew)</u>
<25ft	3
25-29ft	4
30-35ft	5
36-42ft	6
>42ft	7

Single- and double-handed entries will be scored among themselves using PHRF handicap ratings for mixed entry classes - or - by their order of finish within one-design classes in the Random-Leg and Regatta Fleets, as applicable.

- 2 RACE ENTRY & FEES:** Race entry and payment of fees is available online only through Regatta Network (<https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21786>). Entry fees are \$30 (\$25 for members of US Sailing Association).

**1100** First start, Random-Leg Fleet, Mandalay Race Buoy

**1130** First start, Regatta Fleet, AYC’s Wet Wednesday start location

- 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Two (2) sets of Sailing Instructions and corresponding Course Charts will be published and posted online (<https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21786>)

The Random-Leg race will begin at the Mandalay Race Buoy and finish at Channel Islands Harbor. Course options range between 4 and 22nm.

One or more Regatta (windward/leeward) races will start approx 1nm NW of the Channel Islands Harbor breakwater and finish in the same area. Course lengths up to 8nm are planned in the vicinity of Channel Islands Harbor and the Wes Mark. No races will start after 1500hrs.

- 5 RESULTS AND RACE AWARDS:** Approximately 2 hrs after the last boat finishes, Skippers and Crew will be invited to a Zoom meeting (same link as above) to share the results. Individual awards will be distributed separately.

Competitors will acknowledge that they participate entirely at their own risk (see Rule 3, Decision to Race).
