1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the class rules of the individual classes.
- 1.3 R.R.S. 40.1 (PDF) is in effect while afloat.
- 1.4 It is the responsibility of the skipper and all crew participating to comply with current county or state official health regulations in effect on any day they race.

2 Eligibility

- 2.1 Boats of the Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 One-Design classes are eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <u>SCYC.org/racing</u>. Only on-line entries will be accepted.
- 2.3 Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board in the northeast window of the clubhouse upper level and on-line at the Regatta Network event site.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$35 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Wednesday February 10, 2021.
- 3.2 The late entry fee of \$40 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday February 10, 2021.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 0800 hours on Saturday, February 13, 2021.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 There will be no in-person competitors' meeting. A ZOOM virtual meeting will be held on Thursday February 11th at 1830 hours. An invitation to join the meeting will be on Regatta network. https://us02web.zoom.us/j/87341050734?pwd=Nkw0ai9Ua2xjS2MwaXNLUG44QXI3dz09
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1055 hours. Separate starts for the SC 27 and the Moore 24 fleets.
- 4.3 There will not be an awards ceremony. Prizes may be distributed outside of the SCYC clubhouse on Saturday, February 13, 2021 following racing. All participants, both racers and race committee, are expected to exercise social distancing practices consistent with relevant state, county and city ordinances.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be posted online prior to the ZOOM competitors' meeting on February 11, 2021. No hard copies will be provided by the race committee prior to racing.

6 Venue

6.1 Racing will be around fixed and temporary marks within a five-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

7.1 Boats shall round three marks in any order and in either direction as described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 Scoring

8.1 Each fleet will be separately scored.

9 Prizes

9.1 Prizes for each Division will be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
