- 1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the class rules of the invited classes.
- 2. Advertising:** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 3. Venue:** Cold Spring Beach, end of Beach Street, Wickford, RI 02852. The sailing area will be on the West Passage of Narragansett Bay. There will be no dinner on Saturday evening.
- 4. Eligibility and Entry:** The regatta is open to the **505, F-18, 29er, J/22, I-420, Laser, Laser Radial, Finn and RS Aero** classes. All entries shall conform to the eligibility rules of the respective classes.

1500-1800	Check in and late registration
Saturday	June 5, 2021
0830-1000	Check-in and late registration (expect Covid modification)
1000	Competitors meeting (expect Covid modification)
1200	Warning signal first race. Subsequent races to follow immediately.
Sunday	June 6, 2021
1000	Earliest possible start time. Subsequent races to follow immediately.
1500	No races to start after this time.

6.3 The entry fee includes regatta hats (not guaranteed for late registrants). Details are available on the event registration web page.

7. Sailing Instructions: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the event website after June 3, at check in or at the competitor's meeting. The 2019 Sailing Instructions will be available for reference until the 2021 Instructions are posted.

8. Courses: Trapezoid or Windward-Leeward courses will be used for I-420, Finn, RS Aero, Waszp, Laser and Laser Radial Classes. The UFO class will have a special course announced at the competitor's meeting. All other classes will sail Windward-Leeward courses.

9. Scoring: The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules will apply. There will be one throw-out if 4 or more races have been completed. Eight races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

10. Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors will be required to complete a liability waiver at registration.

11. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded based upon the number of entries received through May 20th. 10 or more entries, top three. Fewer than 10, top two. Equal prizes will be awarded to both skipper and crew in double handed classes.
