- Paper copies of Sailing Instructions and the NOR <u>will not be provided</u>. Print your copies to bring with you or view them online through the <u>Official Notice Board</u>.
- Rigging spots are NOT assigned
- Use any location in the east rigging yard but recognize that High School Sailing practice will need to access the 420s after 3 PM Thursday & Friday and at 9 AM Saturday.
- No Food or Drink will be provided at the regatta. You must provide your own.
- Camping on USSCMC property is strictly prohibited by Martin County Parks Department.

TRAILER/VEHICLE PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

We are asking that regatta attendees comply with the following parking rules during the entire 3-day Midwinter Championship:

- ALL SAILBOAT TRAILERS should be parked in west end of lot #2 (on map)
- All <u>VEHICLES</u> attending the regatta <u>may</u> park in either the south Mansion Lot (#1) <u>or</u> the Lot (#2) west
 of our building.
- **PARKING IS NOT ALLOWED** along the sidewalk to the south of our building. Loading and unloading is permitted but no one should leave their vehicle unattended.
- Please keep all vehicles and trailers out of the rigging yard east of the USSCMC building at all times.
- Absolutely **NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING** is allowed in **ANY** lot or on USSCMC property!

Registered competitors are welcome to arrive early. It should be noted that the USSCMC is closed on Mondays and Tuesdays. If you arrive on Monday or Tuesday, you are welcome to set up your boat in our rigging yard and sail at-will. You must know that we will have no one on duty for safety purposes, so sail safe and within your limits while the Sailing Center is closed.

LOT# 3 on the map is for those bringing coach boats or spectator boats. You may park at the boat ramp provided your vehicle remains attached to the trailer during the daytime hours. Lot 3 may also be used if there are any large multi-boat trailers.
