1 RULES

- 1.1 This event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)
- **1.2** The US Sailing prescription to RRS 63.2 will not apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** This regatta is open to all boats of the Force 5 class.
- **4.2** Competitors must be members of the Force 5 Class Association to participate. They may sign up at the Event if they are not already a member.

5 FEES

5.1 An entry fee of \$95 is required to be paid by August 1st, 2021 to avoid a late fee.

5.2 A late fee of \$30 will apply after August 1st, 2021.

7 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Boats may be inspected at any time for class rule compliance at this event. Competitors are responsible for ensuring their equipment is class legal according to the Force 5 class rules. During the competition any boat may be subject to inspection and / or protested for non-compliance with the Force 5 class rules.

8 VENUE AND COURSES

8.1 The racing area will be located approximately 1 miles due east of North Cape Yacht Club on the open waters of Lake Erie.

8.2 Courses will be windward/leeward using drop marks. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

- **9.1** Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **9.2** In accordance with RRS A2.1, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores with no score excluded.

10 PRIZES

- **10.1** The top finisher for the event will be recognized as the 2021 Force 5 North American Champion.
- **10.2** Awards will be made to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th places.
- **10.3** Award will be made to the top Junior (under 18 years of age as of August 14th, 2021) participant.
- **10.4** Award will be made to top Woman Participant
- 10.5 Award to top "Challenger Division" participant. The Challenger Division is comprised of those competitors who have not placed in the top five of a Force 5 North American Championship, a Force 5 Midwinter event or has not won the Challenger Division previously. Participation in the Challenger Division is voluntary and must be declared at check-in.
- **10.6** Other Awards maybe given at the discretion of the Race Chairman.

11 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes. Competitors will be required to sign a waiver and release at check-in.
