### 7. Prizes

- 7.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each fleet and the top boat in each Optimist Red, White, and Blue.

### 8. Support Boats and Personnel

- 8.1.1. All support boats will register during Check-In on Saturday May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021 between 08:00 and 09:30.

### 9. Disclaimer of Liability

- 9.1. Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in these Regattas entirely at their own risk and are reminded to pay special attention to RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers include the Organizing Authority, The Davis Island Yacht Club, Race Committee, Protest Committee, sponsors, volunteers, or any other affiliated organization or official who will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury, illness, or disease to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of practice for or participation in this event during shore side or on-the-water activities. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 9.2. All coaches, parents, guardians and 'designated adults' are support persons (See RRS definition Support Person).
- 9.3. In addition to the requirements of RRS 3 Decision to Race, an adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of their competitor. It is the responsibility of this adult to decide if their competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks.
- 9.4. Parents not personally attending any part of the event shall ensure that another adult is authorized and designated to make these decisions for their sailor.

- 9.5. Each competitor shall indicate in writing at or before check in the parent or adult representative that will be responsible for the competitor throughout the event. The designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes onshore activities before, during, and after the event.
- 9.6. The organizing authority strongly recommends that each sailor have a support (coach or spectator) vessel on the racecourse throughout the event.
