1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. Eligibility and Entry

1. The regatta is open to all Optimist (Green, White, Blue, Red), Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, and C420 classes that have registered at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21945 and have paid the entry fee plus tax for registration.

- 2.2. LATE FEE Entries received after 1500 May 14, 2021 will be charged an additional \$25 and are not guaranteed to receive t-shirts or goodie bags.
- 2.3. The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.
- 2.4. Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent or guardian consent and declaration form at check-in as well as a COVID19 special statement. The forms are available for download on the event website.
- 2.5. Entry fee includes a regatta goodie pack, event t-shirt, lunch (on the water) both days, team refreshments and popsicles post racing each day.

4. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be made available online prior to May 25, 2021.

5. Venue

The racing area will be in Hillsborough Bay, South of Davis Island Yacht Club.

6. Scoring and Qualifying for the Series

- 6.1. One race for a class or fleet must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 6.2. The scoring system is the Low Point System of RRS Appendix A, including A9 (A5.3 in the 2021-2024 RRS), with the following changes:
 - 6.2.1. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - 6.2.2. Rule 90.3(e)(1) will be in effect. There shall be no changes to race or series scores, including the correction of errors, initiated more than 24 hours after the protest time limit for the last race of the series.

7. Prizes

7.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each fleet.

8. Support Boats and Personnel

- 8.1. All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority and will be required to comply with event support boat requests.
- 8.2. Except when assisting the Optimist Green Fleet competitors, support boats with team leaders, coaches, and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first fleet to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall, or abandonment.

9. Disclaimer of Liability

9.1. Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in these Regattas entirely at their own risk and are reminded to pay special attention to RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers include the Organizing Authority, The Davis Island Yacht Club, Race Committee, Protest Committee, sponsors, volunteers, or any other affiliated organization or official who will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury, illness, or disease to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of practice for or participation in this event during shore side or on-the-water activities. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

10. COVID-19 Statement

10.1. Competitors are required to follow World Health Organization guidelines with regards to COVID19 and respect the rules of the Organizing Authority's COVID19 mitigation.
