## To the Bridge and Back 50K April 24, 2021

### **NOTICE OF RACE**

Sail the long waters of Kentucky Lake in one of the Commonwealth's oldest Regattas!

### **Awards in Classes:**

Spinnaker, JAM A, JAM B, Multihull, Cruiser, One Design fleets with 3 or more vessels.

**Rules:** The race shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 or as modified by special instructions issued at the Skippers Meeting.

**Eligibility:** The regatta is open to all sailing vessels.

**Entries**: The race entry fee is \$25 for early entrants registering on or before April 12, and \$30 for entries after that date. Registration is available online at www.RegattaNetwork.com listed under the 2021 Riddle Cup. Registration is also available in person at the registration table on the poop deck at Lighthouse Landing in Grand Rivers, KY, on April 23, 2021 from 6 to 8 p.m. Please observe social distancing and wear a mask.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing instructions will be posted on www.RegattaNetwork.com. Further instructions will be available at the registration meeting on April 23rd.

#### **Schedule:**

April 23	6 p.m.	Registration and Cookout at Lighthouse Landing
	8 p.m.	Skippers meeting.
April 24	9 a.m.	On the water check in with committee boat on VHF
April 25	10 a.m.	Awards at poop deck at Lighthouse Landing.

**Notices:** On the water Notices will be broadcast on VHF channel 72.

**Equipment:** Each yacht shall carry a radio capable of receiving and transmitting on VHF channel 72, shall carry a red protest flag, and have all required USCG safety equipment including wearing PDF's.

**Race Course:** A starting line will be established by the Committee Boat at or about mile 24 on the Tennessee River. The course will proceed south. The Star Lime Works nun buoy, at mile marker 29.3, is to be taken to starboard. The return mark in the race is the last red nun buoy before the Eggners Ferry Bridge at mile marker 49.5 and is to be taken to port. Vessels then return to the point of beginning, back down the lake to the Committee Boat, taking the Star Lime Works nun buoy to port. The course may be adjusted due to weather conditions at the time of race.

**Skippers Meeting:** Skippers meeting will be held at 7 p.m. on April 23rd at the Lighthouse Landing poop deck Friday. Racers and crew are welcome to join in a cookout, compliments of the KLSC Commodore. Bring your own beverage.

**Start Time:** The first race signal will begin approximately 9 a.m. Fleet Flags will be assigned at the Skippers Meeting. Vessels will check in with the Committee Boat on the water on VHF Channel 72.

**Protests:** Official protests will be handled according to the RRS 2021-2024.

**Awards:** Awards will be issued to the top three boats in each class. PHRF handicaps will be assigned, and time on time correction factor will be utilized. Classes will be organized at the Skippers Meeting. The Cruiser Class boats consist of vessels which have not placed in a KLSC event during the past year, including this event. The Cruiser Class boats will start on JAM A or JAM B starting sequence, depending on PHRF. Results will be posted online at www.RegattaNetwork.com, Kentucky Lake Sail Club Facebook page, and at Lighthouse Landing.

Each waives all claims which they, any heir, representative, successor or assignee may have against the Kentucky Lake Sailing Club, its officers, trustees, members, committees, race officials, or agents arising out of participation in this regatta or activity. Competitors shall wear a personal flotation device (PFD) approved by the U.S. Coast Guard.
