1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 [The prescriptions of US Sailing will apply including Appendix V.
- 1.3 The rules and bylaws of the International Sunfish Class Association will apply. (Class Rules)
- 1.4 Under RRS 87, rule 1.3 may be changed in the sailing instructions or as posted on the official notice board.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 While on the water, each competitor is required to wear a USCG-approved personal Floatation Devise, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Sunfish class, skippered by a registered member of the International Sunfish Class Association. Juniors must meet age requirements, ISCA rules.
- 2.2 Registration must be only. <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21983</u>
- 2.3 ISCA Rules decide entry to the **Sunfish World Championship Regatta.**

3. FEES

3.1 Registration fee is \$75.00. The registration fee includes a light breakfast, lunch and casual barbecue dinner on Saturday. Breakfast and lunch on Sunday. Complimentary keg after racing.

4. SCHEDULE

Friday, May 21

1700-1830 check-in (Masks required) TRYC chartroom bar is reserved for Sunfish sailors.

0800-0930 Check-in (Masks Required)

- 0800-0930 Continental Breakfast and bagged lunch available for pick up
- 0900 Skippers Meeting
- 1030 First Warning

Barbecue after racing

Sunday, May 23

0830-0930 Continental Breakfast and bagged lunch available for pick up

1030 First Warning

On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1400

5. MEASUREMENT

Each boat and equipment must be compliant with current International Sunfish Class Association rules.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. VENUE

The regatta will take place on the "Wanamaker Course" at the mouth of the Toms River or Barnegat Bay south of the Toms River.

8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward, triangles, or combination thereof. Courses may include an offset mark or gate as described in the sailing instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

US Sailing prescription V will apply.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 One (1) race will constitute a regatta.
- 10.2 A maximum of seven (7) races will be sailed.
- 10.3 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS will apply with the following modifications: When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept at the Toms River Yacht Club in an area assigned by the organizing authority. All boats must be at the regatta site by 0900 hours on Saturday May 22, and remain there for the duration of the Regatta, except with written permission of the Regatta Organizing Authority.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- a) Top 5 finishers
- b) Highest Place Youth
- c) Highest Place Master

14. CHANGES TO THE NOR

The organizing authority retains the right to modify the NoR at anytime. This will be posted on the event Regatta Network website notice board.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE

The Organizing Authority recommends that each participating boat shall be insured with valid thirdparty liability insurance.

17. SPECIAL COVID RULES

- A. Social distancing is mandatory. Masks are absolutely required while on the dock, parking lot, in clubhouse or other covered area where social distancing is not possible.
- B. All participants shall have the ability to "self-shelter" (i.e. cars, etc.) on-premises in the event of inclement weather. Additional shelter will be provided but may be insufficient for conditions or social distancing.
