NOTICE OF RACE

<u>1 Rules</u> The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

RRS Rule 40: Personal Flotation Devices.

"Y" flag will not be flown. This changes RRS Rule 40.1

<u>2 Eligibility & Entry</u> The Regatta is open to centerboard, multi-hull and keel boats. One design fleets with four or greater entries may be given a one-design start.

Competitors may enter online by 2200 May 28, 2021, by completing the Event Registration Form found on http://www.regattanetwork.com, click on Calendar and go

to Regatta List to find the 56^{TH} Whiskeytown Memorial Weekend Regatta.

Competitors may also enter by completing an Entry Form available on http://www.whiskeytownsailing.org under the "Regatta" tab. Mail or deliver by 0830, Saturday, May 29 2021.

3 Fees The fee to race in the Regatta is \$60.00. Early entries received by May 1, 2021, may

take a \$10 discount. US Sailing members receive a \$5.00 discount.

5 Sailing Instructions Sailing Instructions will be available after 1600 hours, Friday, May 29, 2021 at the

Regatta Headquarters at Brandy Creek Marina. Instructions will also be available on the Whiskeytown Sailing Club website, www.whiskeytownsailing.org on or before May

28, 2021.

6 Venue The racing area shall be the main body of water of Whiskeytown Lake. A detailed map

is available at www.whiskeytownsailing.org under the "Regatta" tab.

<u>7 Courses</u> The diagram in Attachment "A" shows the location of the racing area, the courses, the

order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

The courses to be sailed will be designated from the Race Committee Signal Barge.

The marks shall be cylindrical floats bearing a number corresponding to the course

chart. Marks "A", "B" and "C" will be inflatable orange marks.

8 Penalty System The RRS Appendix "V" shall apply.

<u>9 Berthing</u> Contact Oak Bottom Marina, 530-359-2269 for availability.

10 Launching A launch ramp is available at Brandy Creek Marina

11 Scoring One race is required to constitute a regatta.

When 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her races scored

excluding her worst score. If fewer than 6 races are completed a boat's series score

will be the total of her races. This changes RRS A2.

<u>12 Prizes</u> Three trophies shall be awarded for each class.

13 Decision to Race The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is

hers alone. RRS 3

14 Insurance All competitors shall maintain marine liability insurance throughout the regatta
