- 1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined by the current edition of the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).*
- **Eligibility:** All skippers should be current members of the FSSA. FSSA membership is required for consideration of scoring to be Florida District Champion.

 All boats will sail in the Championship Division.

 Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skipper's Meeting or on-line.
- 2. Fees: See Registration Form. http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22011
- 3. **Schedule:** At least five races are planned.

The Skipper's Meeting will be at 10:30 at the Kelly Park Pavilion.

The Skipper's Meeting will also be broadcast on VHF channel 72.

The Skipper's Meeting is not mandatory and Sailing Instructions will be available online.

4. Measurement: Boats and sails must conform to the Official Plan.

Each boat must carry equipment required by FSSA Specification Article S-V.2 (Racing Restrictions). **Each boat must have functioning bow floatation and appropriate ground tackle on-board their boat.**

- 5. **Courses to be sailed:** The courses to be sailed will be windward / leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6. **Berthing:** It is recommended that the boats be kept on their trailers overnight.
- 7. **Scoring:** The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used.

Five (5) races minimum are scheduled, of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a regatta.

If more than five (5) races are completed, competitors will be able to throw out their highest scored races down to five (5) races total scored.

8. **Prizes:** Awards will be presented to the top 3 boats of the Regatta (all participants).
