NOTICE OF RACE

As amended 9/4/21 to incorporate changes of Amendments #1 and #2

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2021 2024 (RRS).
- 1.2. Pursuant to RRS Rule 87, J/105 Fleet 3 has granted permission to modify the J/105 Class Rules for local CBYRA events as follows:
 - 1.2.1. CR 7.1 is replaced with Local Fleet rules 9.1.3 and 9.1.4 except the waiver regarding sail purchases and royalties. Sail purchases and royalties must still follow the Class Rules.
 - 1.2.2. Local Fleet Rule 9.1.6 is allowed.
- 1.3. The Nearshore Category of the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (SERs) will apply as changed below.
 - (a) In the event of a conflict between the SERs and applicable class rules, the class rules shall govern.
 - (b) The following SERs will also apply:
 - SER 2.4.1, Lifelines
 - SER 2.7.2, Mechanical Propulsion
 - SER 3.14, GPS receiver
 - SER 3.22, Soft plugs for through-hull fittings
 - SER 3.24.1, Lights
 - SER 3.26, Radar reflector
 - SER 3.35, Rigging: Halyards

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats with a valid 2021 PHRF of the Chesapeake rating, 2021 ORC rating, 2021 CRCA rating, 2021 Chesapeake Multihull Association rating, or 2021 SCHRS Beach Cat rating. The rating certificate must be on board.
- 2.2. Starts will be given to all PHRF classes, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, CHESS, J-30, J-105, Alberg 30, CRCA and Multihull classes as long as a minimum of 3 paid entries per class have been received by the deadline of Friday, September 10.
- 2.3. Boats with both PHRF and ORC ratings may be dual scored and pay only one fee. However, such boats must register in both classes.
- 2.4. Boats racing in ORC will be scored as a single class.

- 2.5. Eligible boats must register by going to the TAYC website (<u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 1200 on Friday, September 10.
- 2.6. All regatta participants, including skippers and crew, must individually sign and electronically submit the Covid-19 waiver found at www.tayc.com/racing.

3. FEES

3.1. The entry fee is \$40 for CBYRA or USSA members, \$45 for non-members to be received no later than 1200 on Friday, September 10.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Participants shall rendezvous beginning at 0800 approximately 0.4 nm S of Choptank River Area Mark "N" (R "2") off Tred Avon Yacht Club and must check in with the Check-in Boat flying the "L" flag prior to their Warning Signal.
- 4.2. The Warning Signal for the first class to start is scheduled for 0830. Classes will generally be started in reverse order, with slower classes starting first.
- 4.3. Handicap classes may be combined for starting and scoring purposes at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 4.4. Skippers, crew and guestsare invited by TAYC to the Hammond Memorial Party Saturday afternoon and evening featuring a la carte dinner and cash bar.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the event website no later than 1700 September 10.

6. THE VENUE

6.1. The courses may use government buoys and/or drop marks in the Choptank and Tred Avon Rivers.

7. TIME LIMIT

7.1. 8 hours for first boat in class, subsequent boats must finish within 2 hours of the first boat in its class.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 8.2. Corrected times for PHRF classes will be calculated using PHRF Time-on-Time and CircularRandom ratings.
- 8.3. Corrected times for the ORC classes will be calculated using ORC Time-on-Time TripleNumber ratings.
- 8.4. Corrected times for the CRCA-ORR classes will be calculated using handicaps supplied by the CRCA-ORR class administration based upon course type and observed wind strength.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1. Boats should monitor VHF channel 71 for courtesy broadcasts from the Race Committee.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 entries, 2 if 5 entries, 3 if 7 or more entries.
- 10.2. There will be no award ceremony.
- 10.3. Prizes will be shipped to all winners. Results will be posted at <u>www.tayc.com/racing.</u>

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

13. SPECIAL COVID-19 REGATTA RULES

13.1. Current state and local requirements for protection against the transmission of Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta. Masks and social distancing are recommended for those who have not been fully vaccinated.
