





SAILING INSTRUCTINS (SIs)

1 RULES

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted before 1630 hrs on the electronic official notice board located at: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22081

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located at the MPYC Clubhouse. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 Minutes after flag AP is lowered.

4 SCHEDULE

A competitor briefing will be held at 1650 hrs each day at the launch ramp. The warning signal for the first race will be at 1730 hrs. Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race.

5 STARTING SYSTEM

RRS Appendix U, Audible-Signal Racing System will be used.

6 MARKS, COURSE, And START/FINISH LINES

Mark S/F is an inflatable ball.

Mark A is an inflatable ball mark to be rounded to port.

Marks B are inflatable balls. If one mark is set, round it to port. If two marks are set, it is a gate.

The Starting line is between mark S/F and an orange flag in the signal vessel. The Finishing line is between mark S/F and an orange flag in the signal vessel.

Course: Start – A – B – A – B - Finish

7 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be one hour for the first boat to finish.

8 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the race committee within one hour after the race committee finish boat docks.
