**NOTICE OF RACE and SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (3/21/2021)**

**1. Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and BBYRA NOR and Sailing Instructions, 2020-2021.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

2.1 The regatta is open to all Youth Program members ("Members") (see below) of the Coconut Grove Sailing Club ("CGSC") sailing their own or CGSC owned boats in the following classes: **Laser, Optimist RWB and Optimist Green**

2.2 The regatta is open to such boats, provided that there is a minimum of three entries in each class

**All entries for must be received by 1600 hours, Wednesday, April 7, 2021.** The Race Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.

**3. Fees**

Required fee is \$20. CGSC Members can charge their fee to their Club account

**4. Schedule**

4.1 There will be a Virtual Skippers Meeting via Zoom at 1830 hours on Friday April 9. Join Zoom Meeting at

4.2 The regattas may consist of up to five races. One race in each class racing shall constitute a regatta.

4.3 Fleets will have a 5 minute starting sequence. This changes BBYRA OD3.1.

4.4 Unless modified at the Skippers Meeting, the starting sequence for the first race of this regatta shall be as follows:

| Junior Lasers  | 11:30/11:35                           | Laser Class          |
| Optimist RWB   | 11:40/11:45                           | RWB Opti Class       |
| Optimist Green | 11:50/11:55                           | Green Opti Class     |

Additional races will follow on a "back-to back" basis (as soon as practical) on a similar starting sequence.

**5. Sailing Instructions**

The BBYRA NOR and SI for 2020-2021, Part I -- General Conditions and Sailing Instructions and Part II – Sailing Instructions: One Design (available at [www.bbyra.net](http://www.bbyra.net)) are hereby adopted as the Sailing Instructions for this regatta, except as provided for below:

- 5.1 Verbal changes to the SI's on the water will be allowed and announced by raising flag L with one sound and verbally communicating the change to the competitors.
- 5.2 Race Committee will be on Channel 73. Coaches are to monitor this Channel for any notices from the Race Committee.

**6. Venue**

- 6.1 The event venue shall be the Coconut Grove Sailing Club, Coconut Grove, FL.

The safety of sailors and volunteers is paramount. All skippers, crews and interested parties must comply with all CGSC Health protocols. Please remember to socially distance at least six feet away from others, to wear a mask at all times while ashore, regularly wash your hands, and avoid touching your face. If you have any symptoms of Covid-19 or are feeling unwell, you shall stay away from the event premises and competitors.

**7. The Courses**

- 7.1 Courses will be announced at or prior to the Skippers Meeting.

**8. Protests**

- 8.1 Protests shall be delivered to the Protest Desk within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Protest hearings will be conducted virtually (via Zoom) as soon as possible and in the approximate order in which they were filed. This changes BBYRA 15.2 Penalties and Protests.

**9. Prizes**

- 9.1.1 Three trophies will be awarded for each class. The Perpetual Trophies will remain in the custody of the Coconut Grove Sailing Club.
- 9.1.2 Trophy presentation will be held as soon as possible following the final race of the day

**10. Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 3, Decision to Race and Rule 4, Acceptance of the Rules. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
