Notice of Race

1 Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 Sailing Instructions

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available at 1:00pm PST on April 10th at www.scyc.org/racing.

3 Communication

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at www.scyc.org/racing.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Santana 22, Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 classes.
- 4.2 Other one-design classes with at least three entries may petition to participate prior to 1100 hours on Thursday, April 15th, 2021.
- 4.3 Boats may enter the event by registering online at www.scyc.org/racing.

5 Fees

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$105.00 if entry is completed by 2000 hour on Wednesday April 14th, 2021.
- 5.2 The late entry fee of \$125.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday April 14th, 2021.
- 5.3 The one-day entry fee is \$40.00 and must be received by 1100 hour on the day of racing. One day entries will not be scored in the series. This changes RRS A2.2.
- 5.4 Registration closes at 1100 hours on Saturday, June 26, 2021.

6 Schedules

- 6.1 A competitors briefing is scheduled for 1100 hours on Saturday, April 17, 2021 outside the regatta shed.
- 6.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day
- 6.3 For the Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 classes, nine races (9) are scheduled for the series with three (3) races each race day.
- 6.4 For the Santana 22 class, six (6) races are scheduled for the series with two (2) races each race day.
- 6.5 For all classes, 4 races will constitute series.
- 6.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Saturday, June 26th, 2021 following racing.

7 Venue

7.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed marks within a three-mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

8 Courses

8.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

9 Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be given as follows: A daily first place prize will be awarded for each division and series prizes will be awarded at the end of the series based on the number of entries in each division.
- 9.2 The winning boat in any division with three (3) or more entries with a current PHRF rating will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
