1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta is organized by the GYA and hosted by the Mobile Yacht Club.
- 1.2 This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events (available at www.gya.org)

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 All yacht clubs which are current General Members of the Gulf Yachting Association (GYA) are eligible to participate in Capdevielle Viper 640s.
- 2.2 All other invited classes are open to all sailors.

3. INVITED CLASSES ENTRIES AND FEES:

- 3.1 All registrations shall take place on-line at Regatta Network - <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22136>
- 3.2 GYA Capdevielle Viper 640's and Fish Class---No Fee
- 3.3 Finn Class – No Entry Fee.
- 3.4 Viper 640 Open Class- \$30.00
- 3.5 Three (3) boats will constitute a class in any one design fleet.

4. NUMBER OF RACES:

- 4.1 Five (5) races are scheduled for Capdevielle Viper, Open Viper, Finn and Fish classes of which one (1) will constitute a class.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

0900-1030 Free Continental Breakfast – Fruit, Pastries, Juice and Coffee – Bar Will Be Open
1030-1130 Lunch Service Will Be Available
1100 Competitor's Meeting
1255 Warning signal first race of the day (races sailed back-to-back)
1300 PHRF Bermuda start at your assigned starting time

Sunday, July 18th

0800-0930 Free Continental Breakfast – Fruit, Pastries, Juice and Coffee – Bar Will Be Open
1055 Warning signal first race of the day (races sailed back-to-back) No starts after 1430.
Awards ceremony as soon possible following racing for all classes.

6. SAFETY:

All boats shall comply with United States Coast Guard and State safety equipment regulations. It is the responsibility of each skipper to determine if they should start a race, continue racing or if wearing a life jacket is appropriate. This does not supersede any class rules or regulations that may require wearing of life jackets while on the water.

7. SUPPORT BOATS:

As races will be sailed back-to-back, clubs are encouraged to provide support boats for crew changes that may be required on the water.

8. CHANGES TO RACING RULES:

The Sailing Instructions may change some of the RRS.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

10. SCORING:

Each class shall be scored using the low point system of Appendix A with no races excluded. This changes RRS A2.1.

11. TROPHIES:

Trophies for Capdevielle Viper 640s will be awarded in compliance with GYA regulations. Trophies for one design fleets will be awarded for first place and may be awarded for additional places depending on the number of boats competing in the class.
