RULES: All races will be sailed in accordance with current Racing Rules of Sailing and with Class rules where applicable. Sailing instructions will be provided at Registration. One race constitutes a regatta. Six or more races will be attempted. If six or more races are completed, there will be a throw-out race.

CLASSES: Three boats are required to form a class. Expected classes include: Aero, Sunfish, Lasers, Laser Radials, V-15's, Portsmouth.

AWARDS: One trophy will be awarded for 3-4 boats, 2 for 5-7, 3 for 8 or more. For the Laser Class, District 15 Grand Prix Points will be awarded as described by the ILCANA Grand Prix Rules

1. \$50 Single-handed Registration on or before June 16. \$40 for Seabrook Sailing Club members

2. \$60 Late Registration fee on June 17 through June 20, \$50 for Seabrook Sailing Club members

3. Registration pays for one meal ticket. If you have additional crew, family or guests, please purchase additional meal tickets at time of registration for \$20
