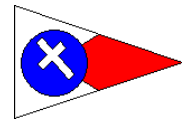


2021 Spring Score / Double Handed Series

Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The series is open to any boat holding a valid Monterey Bay PHRF certificate for 2021.
- 2.2. There will be following PHRF divisions: A fleet (86 or less), B Fleet (greater than 86), Double Handed, Jib & Main (181 or less) and Jib & Main (greater than 181). The race committee may adjust the PHRF cutoffs between divisions depending on entries by April 21, 2000 to ensure that there will be a minimum of 3 entries per division.
- 2.3. Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons on board.
- 2.4. Other divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form for the event listed at www.scyc.org/racing.

3. Fees

- 3.1. The regular entry fee is \$105 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on April 21, 2021.
- 3.2. The late entry fee is \$125 and is applicable to all entries received after 2000 hours on April 21, 2021.
- 3.3. The one-day entry fee is \$40.00 and must be received by 1100 hour on the day of racing. One day entries will not be scored in the series. This changes RRS A2.2.
- 3.4. Registration closes at 1100 hours on June 27, 2021.

4. Schedules

- 4.1. A briefing for competitors is scheduled for 1100 hours on Sunday, April 25, 2021 outside the regatta shed.
- 4.2. Scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1225 hours on race days.
- 4.3. Two Races are scheduled each day.
- 4.4. A daily awards ceremony is held at the SCYC clubhouse following racing each day.
- 4.5. A final awards ceremony is held at the SCYC clubhouse following racing on June 27, or 1600 on that day if no racing is conducted.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be available at 1800 hours on April 22th at www.scyc.org/racing.

6. Venues, Courses

- 6.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to three miles off shore.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. Three races are required to constitute a series.
- 7.2. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. Prizes

- 8.1. A daily first place prize will be awarded for each division.
- 8.2. Series prizes will be awarded at the end of the series based on number of entries in each division at the end of the first race day.
- 8.3. The winning boat in each division of three or more entries in the series will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
