Mission Bay Yacht Club (MBYC) is the Organizing Authority (OA) of this regatta.

1. RULES

- 1.1. This event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)
- 1.2. The Lido 14 Class Association requirement for competitors to be members of the Lido 14 Class Association and for entrants to own an interest in a Lido 14 class boat is waived; this changes Lido 14 Class Association Bylaw Article IX.8
- 1.3. The Lido 14 Class Association requirement for competitors to carry ballast weight for either their boat and themselves is waived; this changes Lido 14 Class Association Bylaws Article XII.7 and Article XV.4

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Any person not yet be nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31, 2021 may sail in the Junior division
- 2.2. Any woman may sail in the Women's division.
- 2.3. To enter, an entry form will be provided during Check-In.
- 2.4. Liability Release and Parental Consent forms for competitors under the age of Eighteen (18) years, as of the start of this event, must be submitted at Check-In; these will be available online at www.lidochampionship2021.com and at the Check-In desk.
- 2.5. Entries will be accepted until 10:00 AM PST on August 19, 2021.

3. FEES

There is no entry fee.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Five (5) races are scheduled for each division.
- 4.2. The schedule of events is as follows:

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be provided at Check-In.

6. THE VENUE

- 6.1. Check-In will be at the Fleet Room of the Bodrero Building, which is located on the South-East portion of the MBYC grounds.
- 6.2. All racing will be in "Sail Bay" which is directly East of the MBYC clubhouse.
- 6.3. There are two hoists available to launch boats. Boats shall provide their own internal lifting sling.

7. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward leeward courses using movable marks located throughout the "Sail Bay". The course chart will be provided at Check-In.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. RRS Appendix A will apply, except that a boat's scores will be the sum of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.1
- 8.2. Three (3) completed races shall constitute a series.
- 8.3. The Junior and Women's may be sailed together but will be scored separately.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top boat of the Junior and Women's divisions.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
