12:00 am – First Starting Signal on the Neuse River off Broad Creek in vicinity of markers 17/19/2 (2-3 races planned - around buoys style) 5:00 pm – Shore Party at the Parker Waterfront Campground (Seafood and Soulfood available from the Sea&Soul food truck, as well as our non unlimited supply of Beer & Wine for those of sufficient maturity) Masks encouraged, plenty of room for social distancing. # Anticipated Classes for Spinnaker, Non Spinnaker and Fun Class Boats

Friendly Racing for new and old in Fun Class - great chance to learn new skills and meet other sailors! Great tune up for the 4th Saturday fun racing series also! The Regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing. All boats shall comply with N.C. Wildlife Commission and U.S. Coast Guard safety regulations. Multiple races are planned for the NYRA Invitational Regatta; one completed race will constitute the regatta.

# Eligibility:

The Regatta is open to any Yacht holding a current NC-PHRF. Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at NYRA.org (under the "Race Registration" tab), and paying the required fees to NYRA. Late entries will be accepted via online registration until 7:30 pm April 16.

## Classes:

A minimum of three boats will constitute a class. There will be classes for spinnaker, non-spinnaker, fun, and multi hull fleets. Each fleet may be broken into multiple classes based on PHRF rating, depending on the number of entries, at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

## Scoring:

NYRA Invitational Regatta - PHRF handicap system Time on Time scoring. Pursuit start racing on Sunday

A NC-PHRF Rating Request form that can be submitted for boats that do not have a current rating is available at http://www.ncphrf.com/. If you need to apply for a rating, please send the completed and signed Request Form and check no later than 1 week prior to the regatta to the address on the form. Fun class sailors can apply for a temporary rating; contact <u>bod@nyra.org</u>
