

Sunset Series 2021

<u>NOTICE OF RACE</u> Spring Series: May 4 – May 18 – June 1 – June 15

Summer Series: July 20 – August 3 – August 17 – August 31

The Sausalito Yacht Club invites Bay Sailors to come out for the Sunset Series. Races are held on alternate Tuesday evenings in two four-race Series, designated Spring and Summer. Racing will take place in the Knox / Yellow Bluff area using courses optimized for conditions.

1. Entry is open to all yachts with a current PHRF certificate or members of one-design fleets. Five or more one-design entries may constitute a class. Yachts without a PHRF Certificate may be assigned a rating at the discretion of the Race Committee.

2. Competitors may complete their entry online through the event website at one of the following links:

They may also request a mail-in entry form at <u>race@sausalitoyachtclub.org</u>, or at the club.

3. The Entry fee for an individual series is \$80; for both Spring and Summer, \$140. Individual races are \$35. Entries for the Spring Series submitted after May 2nd will be subject to an \$20 late entry fee. Entries for the Summer Series submitted after July 18th will be subject to an \$20 late entry fee.

4. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) (2021-2024) shall govern this Series. Also confirmation by the boat owner/representative that they will comply with the RRS and all other rules that govern this event. The navigation rules of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions (IRPCAS), replaces Part 2 of the previous versions of the RRS.

5. The completion of one race will constitute a series. For each series, if four races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score; otherwise, her score will be the total of her scores for the series. RRS A5.3 applies.

6. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the event website and available at the club no later than 1800 Monday May 3rd.

7. The first warning signal for each race will be sounded at 1830.

8. Results will be posted to the club's race notice board after each race and on the appropriate event website the evening following the race. Or email:<u>race@sausalitoyachtclub.org</u>.

9. Trophies will be awarded to winners of individual races after each race. Series trophies will be awarded to series entries after the last race of each series. Single race entries are not eligible for Series trophies. At the conclusion of the Summer Series a perpetual trophy, The Lischeske Trophy, will be awarded. This goes jointly to the lowest scoring spinnaker and non-spinnaker competitors, from any class, across the two series.

Based upon the Marin County Health Regulations and YRA guidance in effect as of this posting, racers are invited to return to the SYC for presentation of trophies, as well as no-host bar and food. In compliance with current regulations, reservations will be required. They can be made by contacting the club at <u>reservations@sausalitoyachtclub.org</u>.

These arrangements will be reviewed as necessary (based on the health regulations and YRA guidelines in force prior to each race) with amendments provided.
