LAUNCHING AND HAULING SERVICE

Burr Brothers Boats, 309 Front Street, Marion, MA, is providing free launching and hauling service for visiting boats arriving via trailer. Be sure to indicate that you need launching and hauling service when you register; see https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22220 for additional details.

MOORINGS AND LAUNCH SERVICE

Limited moorings are available, compliments of BYC, if pre-reserved on the Regatta Network registration form. Be sure to indicate that you need a mooring when you register; see https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22220 for additional details. Use of a BYC mooring also includes use of the Club's restroom/shower facilities.

When arriving, contact the BYC launch on Channel 68 when passing the lighted red buoy (#8) at the entrance to Sippican Harbor. A BYC launch will guide you to a mooring. Launch service will be available throughout the event.
