Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

Posted April 23, 2021

- 1 RULES
- **1.1** This document supersedes all previous NoR and SIs for this event.
- **1.2** The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- **1.3** US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2, and RRS 81 will not apply.

2 **COMMUNICATION**

- **2.1** The official online notice board is located at dryc.org.
- **2.2** On the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make oral changes and broadcast information on VHFchannel 68.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY, FEES, DIVISIONS, and CLASSES

- 3.1 There will be 2 divisions, PHRF and Cruising. The class flags and scheduled starting times will be posted before 1900 the day before the race.
- **3.2** If the RC deems an entry unsuitable for the Cruising Division, it may be moved to the PHRF Division.
- **3.3** Entries and payments shall be submitted at dryc.org no later than 1800 the day before the race. The entry fee is \$15.

4 SCHEDULE AND COURSES

- **4.1** The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155.
- **4.2** After starting, sail the course signaled by the RC (Code flag A, B, or C):

Course A – (32nm) Round the yellow inflatable mark at approximately 34° 00.000 N and 118° 47.000 W), leaving the mark to port. Proceed to **SI 4.3.**

Course B - (22.4nm) Round the buoy labeled "CG", at approximately 34° 02.087′ N 118° 40.222′ W, leaving the mark to port. The buoy is a white ball with a blue stripe and "CG" in black font. Proceed to **SI 4.3.**

Course C- (13nm) Round the yellow inflatable mark at approximately 34º 01.800' N 118º 33.804' W, leaving the buoy to port. Proceed to **SI 4.3.**

4.3 All classes except AA, round the inflatable mark at approx. 33° 57.352′ N 118° 27.582′ W, leaving it to port (see Addendum 2). The RC will attempt to light this mark. All classes proceed to SI 6.1.

5 THE START

- **5.1** The starting area will be in the vicinity or MdR H mark (See MdR Course Chart 17).
- **5.2** The starting line will be between an inflatable mark and an orange flag on the RC boat.

6 THE FINISH

- 6.1 There will be 2 finishing lines, one for PHRF AA and one for all other classes (see Addendum 2). Boats finishing after 1930 shall illuminate their sail number.
- 6.2 The RC intends to be on station until 2030. If the RC is not on station, record your finish time when the green light on the south end of thedetached breakwater bears 200° from your bow.
- 6.3 All boats shall complete and email a photograph of the Race Report Form (Addendum 1) to the Event Chairman (see SI 11) within 30 minutes of finishing or retiring. A boat's sail number and finish time shall be in the email subject line (this changes RRS 35, 63.1 and A5.1).
- **6.4** A boat not finishing by 2300 will be scored DNF without a hearing (this changes RRS 35 and A 51).

7 HEARING REQUESTS

The protest time limit is 30 minutes after a boat finishes. A boat shall inform the RC of her intention to protest on their Race Report Form.

8 SCORING

The race will be scored using PHRF Area B RLC ratings.

9 PRIZES

This is a stand alone race and trophies will be awarded to each class (based on number of entries) and to winners of each division.

10 RISK STATEMENT

Competitors participate in these races entirely at their own risk (see RRS 3). By participating in these races, each competitor and crew agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors and any others acting in any official capacity for these races) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

THE FINISH

The finishing line for all classes except for PHRF AA will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and the green light on the south end of MDR detached breakwater.

The finishing line for PHRF AA ONLY will be a 200 foot extension of a line from an orange flag on the RC boat passing through the inflatable mark. Leave the mark to port.
