## Amendment to Add Quadruplehanded Discipline to the US Sailing's Chubb Junior Sailing Area B NOR

## 1. QUADRUPLEHANDED DISCIPLINE

- 1.1. Teams consist of four persons.
- 1.2. For this discipline only every effort will be made to conduct the event as a full round robin.
- 1.3. Teams shall not in any way adjust standing rigging of any boat in a round robin series during the event, except with the prior consent of the RC.
- 1.4. Each team shall bring their own yellow breakdown flag.
- 1.5. Borrowed Boats
  - 1.5.1. In the quadruple-handed discipline, boats will be provided by the OA.
  - 1.5.2. One (1) quadruple-handed boat will be held for each RSA in the Area until July 10, 2021. After that, any remaining boats will be released first to a second team designated by the GSBYRA, and then to Area B residents of any RSA on a first come, first serve basis.
  - 1.5.3. If the boats are borrowed or chartered from any source other than a manufacturer, the competitors are reminded that they are not covered or protected by the Borrowed Boat Insurance Program, which exists to protect the owner of the boat, not the sailors/borrowers.
- 1.6. Competitors are responsible for ensuring the boats are in shipshape condition each day after racing. [DP]
