1. <u>VENUE</u>:

1.1 The venue will be off the Babylon Yacht Club in the general area of Babylon and West Islip, NY.

- 2. ELIGIBILITY: This is an invitational event.
- 3. ENTRIES: Boats must register at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22272
- 3.1 <u>While not a requirement crews are asked to contact the Regatta Chair by July 1st if intending to participate, this is requested for planning purposes only</u>.

3.2 As a condition of participating in racing at the Babylon Yacht Club, each participant is required to sign the "BYC COVID-19 Hold Harmless Waiver" if they plan on using the club property.

4. <u>RULES</u>:

- 4.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 4.2 Conflicts between the NOR & Sailing Instructions will be resolved in favor of the Sailing Instructions. This changes RRS 63.7.
- 4.3 Classes must consist of 3 boats to be considered a class, except PHRF. Other One-design boats will sail in the Handicap class.
- 4.4 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and online the week prior.
- 4.5 Divisions and fleets may be added/subtracted depending on the number of participants.
- 5. <u>SKIPPER'S MEETING</u>: 10:30AM on the BYC Porch.
- 6. <u>SAFETY</u>: One-Design competitors shall wear a properly fastened US Coast Guard approved Personal Floatation Device (PFD), inherently buoyant, (i.e. not inflatable) while afloat.
- 7. <u>SCORING</u>: The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2, will apply, except that each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

8. COURSES:

8.1 One Design courses will be triangles, trapezoids, windward/leewards or a combination thereof.

- 8.2 PHRF courses will be a combination of government & inflatable marks.
- 9. <u>PRIZES</u>: Prizes will be awarded after racing in the BYC clubhouse.
- **10. <u>BERTHING</u>**: Available at the BYC Dock or Launch areas on a first-come-first-serve basis.
