NOTICE of RACE

1. INTRODUCTION

Bellport Bay Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for this series of races. Races will be conducted on the waters south of the Yacht Club at the south end of Bellport Lane, Bellport, NY 11713. <u>www.bellportbayyachtclub.org</u>

2. RULES

This series of races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021- 2024

3. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & REGISTRATION

3.1 Eligibility -This series is open to all boats of the Optimist (Red, White, Blue and Green), C420, Laser and Sunfish classes.

3.2 Entry and Registration are accomplished by going on-line to Regatta Network, <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22322</u> and completely filling in all required information.

3.3 Fees Registration on or before May 15th is \$40. Registration is \$60 after May 15.

4. SAFETY

RRS 40 applies and all competitors must wear a Coast Guard approved personal flotation device at all time on the water.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available in 'Race Documents in Regatta Network and will be posted with this NOR on the Regatta Notice Board inside the Club house prior to the First Warning Signal of this series.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be directly south of the Club house in Bellport Bay

7. COURSES

Courses will be outlined in the Course Document attached to the Sailing Instructions.

8. MARKS

Mark's will be orange hippity hops or larger inflatable buoys.

9. SCHEDULE

The schedule of races for the first racing day of May 30 will be First Warning Signal at 1230, subsequent races to follow up to a maximum of 4 races per day. Subsequent race days are June 6, 13, and 20. Any races that are abandoned will not be rescheduled or re-sailed. No Races will start after 4pm each day.

10. SCORING

Scoring for this series will be APPENDIX A, Low Point Scoring System. To qualify to be scored for the series a boat in a class must be scored in a minimum of 50% of the races scored for the series. This changes Appendix A2.1.

11. AWARDS

Awards will be given for each class with a minimum of two boats of the same class to qualify to be scored for the series. (See 10. Scoring.) There will be awards for each fleet of Optimist as well as an overall Optimist Winner

12. Boat Storage

Boat's not berthed at BBYC during the summer will be allowed to remain at BBYC on the pad beginning May 29th until the end of the series. All boats not stored at BBYC must be removed 6/20 for the start of our junior sailing season.

13. COVID-19

All competitors, if over 18 or parents or guardians must sign a waiver pertaining to COVID-19. All competitors and their support must always wear mask inside the clubhouse. Masks are required when not able to be socially distant on the pad, beach and lawn. Failure to adhere to social distancing and mask requirements may be subject to withdrawal from the regatta.
