- 2. Eligibility: Entrant must be a member of the Coronado 15 sailing association.
- 3. Classes: Coronado 15
- 4. Entries: Entries must be submitted via Regatta Network. Entries and payment must be received by 9 am, Friday August 6.

- 6. **Sailing Instructions**: Sailing Instructions will be available on RegattaNetwork no later than 2000 hours on Thursday, August 5.
- 7. Courses: Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks. The race area will be north of the Marina del Rey Spar buoys. A minimum of 4 races will be run on Friday. 4 or more races for all classes on Saturday and 3 or more races on Sunday.
- 8. C15 Scoring: On Friday, the Syd Corp cup qualifying series will be run with the first race starting at 13:00 hours. There will be no throw-out. Based on the results from the qualifying series on Friday, "The split between the "A" Fleet and the "B" Fleet shall be made at the 1/2 point or a natural point within three boats of the 1/2 point. This shall be determined by the RACE COMMITTEE." (C15 NAC Policy 4a)

Saturday and Sunday championship scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with one throw out, if 6 or more races are completed.

- 9. **Penalties:** Rule 44 is changed according to RRS appendix V1 so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.
- 10. **C15 Trophies:** The Coronado 15 Syd Corp Cup trophy will be awarded to the 1st place qualifier from the Friday races. For the North American Championship, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd place trophies will be awarded in both the A & B fleets at SCCYC following the last race on Sunday.
- 11. Hospitality: Specific protocol will conform to Los Angeles county health department COVID-19 guidelines at the time of the event. The Coronado 15 class association annual dinner and meeting is planned for Friday at the SCCYC Club house after racing. Informal dinner for all racers as well as a no-host bar may be available at the SCCYC Club House following the racing on each day for a small club donation.
- 12. Launching: At least one SCCYC Flag Member will be available each day to assist non-members in using the hoist.
- Additional information: C15s racing in the North American Championship and/or qualifying series must meet the weight and measurement policies as specified in the By-laws on <u>www.Coronado15.org</u>. Boats and sails that have been measured in past NAC and found to meet the requirements will not be required to be measured again.

Arrange for C-15 measurement by contacting the race chair. Measurements may be arranged Thursday afternoon or Friday morning between 9:00 and 10:00 hours.

<u>Non-participation in the Syd Corp Series</u>: In the event that racers can only participate in the championship series on Saturday and Sunday, the entrant will by default be assigned to the A fleet but may petition the RC to sail in the B fleet.

Sailors from out of town who desire to practice on Thursday 8/5 are invited to sail that day in the sunstroke regatta which takes place in the evening in the main channel of the marina starting at 6:00pm.
