

# **Sailing Instructions**

2021 C15 North American Championship August 6,7,8 Marina del Rey, CA

1. RULES: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

# 2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

Any Notices will be emailed to registered competitors no later than 0930 hours on the day of the race via regatta network.

### 3. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be emailed to registered competitors no later than 0930 hours on the day of the race via regatta network.

# 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

- 5.1. There will be a skipper's meeting at 11:00 on Friday at SCCYC 13444 Bali Way
- 5.2. The first race on each day will start at 1300 hours, with the Warning Signal at 12:57 hours.
- 5.3. The RC will attempt to end racing at 1700 on Friday and Saturday.
- 5.4. On Sunday the RC will attempt to finish racing at 1600.
- 5.5. Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.
- 5.6. There will be 5 or more races on Friday and Saturday
- 5.7. There will be about 3 or more races on Sunday.

### 6. CLASS FLAGS:

6.1. The C15 class flag carries the C15 Logo.

### 7. RACING AREA:

The racing area will be approximately one mile northwest of the north entrance to the marina. Plan ample time – 1hr or more - to reach the race area outside the breakwater. Plan ample time to launch your boat as well.

### 8. COURSES:

- 8.1. Marks W1, W2 and L shall be rounded to port.
- 8.2. Courses will be signaled by a number flag

### 9. MARKS:

- 9.1. Marks W1 and W2 will be inflatable cylinders.
- 9.2. Mark S will be a yellow flag buoy.
- 9.3. The Committee Boat end of the start is a green flag.
- 9.4. Mark L will be an orange inflatable.

### 10. Reserved

#### 11. STARTS:

A three minute sequence will be used. Preparatory P flag goes up at 2 min and goes down at 1 min from the start.

### 13. FINISH

13.1 Mark F will be an orange hippity hop.

13.2 The Committee Boat end of the finish line will is a blue flag.

### **14. PENALITES:**

Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, rule 44.2 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty. This means that an incident within the zone will take a Two-Turns penalty.

### **15. TIME LIMIT AND TARGET TIMES.**

There are no time limits nor target times.

#### 16. PROTESTS:

Protesting boats are asked to notify the Race Committee at the finish line of their intent to pro-test. Protests must be filed at SCCYC within one hour of the Race Committee's return to the Clubhouse.

#### 17. SCORING:

When fewer than 5 (5) races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

#### **18. RADIO COMMUNICATION:**

The Race Committee will monitor channel 68.

### **19. HOSPITALITY / PRIZES:**

SCCYC will have food free to all racers Friday, Saturday and Sunday. No host donation bar will be open.

#### **20. INFORMATION:**

# C15.1 Scoring:

On Friday C-15s are racing the Syd Corp cup qualifying series. Based on the results from the qualifying series on Friday, The split between the "A" Corinthian Fleet and the "B" Cabrillo Fleet shall be made at the 1/2 point or a natural point within three boats of the 1/2 point. This shall be determined by the RACE COMMITTEE." (C15 NAC Policy 4a). A boat entering the NAC without participating in the Syd Corp Series may petition the Race Committee to sail in either A or B fleet.

# **C15.2 Measurements:**

C15s racing in the North American Championship and/or qualifying series must meet the weight and measurement policies as specified in the By-laws on www.Coronado15.org.

Measurements may take place in the afternoon of August 5<sup>th</sup> or starting at 9:00am on Friday August 6<sup>th</sup>.

# C15.3 Trophies:

The Coronado 15 Syd Corp Cup trophy will be awarded to the 1st place qualifier from the Friday races. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd place trophies will be awarded in both the A & B fleets will be awarded for the C15 North American Championship.

# C15.4 Coronado 15 Association:

The Coronado 15 annual dinner and meeting will be held on Friday at the SCCYC club house after racing. It will be catered by Sapori Italian restaurant and free for all racers.
