



## **2021 Naples Sabot Senior Championship Senior, Master, Grand Master and Clydesdale Divisions**

### **NOTICE OF RACE**

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

The Organizing Authority for the 2021 Naples Sabot Senior Class Championship will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club (ABYC), 7201 East Ocean Blvd, Long Beach, CA. 90803 in conjunction with the International Naples Sabot Association (INSA).

#### **1. RULES**

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. RRS 44.1 will be changed such that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced with a One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.3. RRS 26 will be changed as follows: Warning signal will be given three (3) minutes before the starting signal. The Preparatory signal will be given two (2) minutes before the Starting signal.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all members of the Naples Sabot Class declared eligible by INSA, who hold a 2021 INSA membership and have a 2021 transom sticker. All boats must have a valid measurement certificate or be confirmed by the INSA Chief Measurer as valid.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at [www.abyc.org](http://www.abyc.org), paying the entry fee, and completing measurement.
- 2.3. Late entries will be accepted until Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 10:30 am.
- 2.4. Divisions for the regatta are: Seniors, Masters, Grand Masters and Clydesdale classes, which will race separately.
  - a) Senior class competitors must be 18 years old or older by the first day of the regatta.
  - b) Masters class competitors must be 40 years old or older by the first day of the regatta.
  - c) Grand Masters class competitors must be 65 years old or older by the first day of the regatta.



## 7. VENUE

- 7.1. ABYC is located on Alamitos Bay, which is situated in the South Eastern part of Long Beach California.
- 7.2. The races will be held in the enclosed waters of Alamitos Bay.

## 8. THE COURSES

Courses will be a windward leeward or triangle windward leeward.

## 9. SCORING

- 9.1. Senior, Master and Clydesdale Championship Series: Six (6) races are scheduled of which three (3) must be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2. Grand Master Championship Series: Three (3) races are scheduled of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. When six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores, excluding her worst score.

## 10. PENALTIES

The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 will be a One-Turn Penalty, this changes Rule 44.1.

## 11. PRIZES

11.1. Prizes will be given as follows:

- a) Senior and Master Gold Classes – Prizes to be awarded based on the number of paid entrants:

Five (5) boats	One (1) trophy;
Six (6) to Eight (8)	Two (2) trophies;
Nine (9) to 11	Three (3) trophies;
12 to 14	Four (4) trophies;
15 or more	Five (5) trophies.

- b) Master Silver, Grand Master and Clydesdale Classes – First take home

11.2. Perpetual Trophies

- a) Senior National Championship Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Senior Fleet.
- b) Edward Gaudio Memorial Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Masters Fleet.
- c) Grand Masters Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Grand Masters Fleet.
- d) Clydesdale Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Clydesdale Division.

## 12. HOSPITALITY AND SOCIAL

12.1. Included in registration. Note, due to Government Health Regulations, attendance will be limited.

12.2. The ABYC bar will be open after racing both days.

### **14. SAFETY**

- 14.1. [DP]All participants shall practice social distancing when ashore at ABYC
- 14.2. [DP]All participants shall wear masks when ashore at ABYC.

### **15. PARKING**

[DP] Due to space limitations, vehicle parking on ABYC grounds is restricted. Off-street parking is available across the street in municipal lots.

### **16. DEPICTION RELEASE**

Competitors, by competing in this regatta, grant to the Host, perpetually and irrevocably, the unconditional and exclusive right, title and interest throughout the world to use, simulate and portray Participant's name, likeness, voice, personality, personal identification and personal experiences, incidents, situations and events, whether visual and/or audio, including without limitation photographs, videotape, film and other recordings, electronic or optical-based media, or any other form or medium whatsoever, whether now or hereafter existing, and of every kind and character (collectively "The Images"), which may be taken or taken of Participant while participating in any aspect of the Regatta.
