



# 2021 Pram Jam Regatta

May 8, 2021 at *Davis Island Yacht Club*

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Competitors shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the event website ([Registration Link](#)). Entries are limited to (16) "Old Salt" and (16) "New Salts" and must be received no later than 1700 on May 7, 2021.
- 2.2 All competitors must feel comfortable with basic maneuvers and upwind sailing in a dinghy.
- 2.3 Competitors shall be defined by the following criteria:
  - Old Salt: Adults 18 years or older who are affiliated with Davis Island Youth Sailing (DIYSF) and/or Davis Island Yacht Club (DIYC)
  - New Salt: Youth sailors who participate or have participated in DIYSF programs
- 2.4 Competitors will be paired randomly into Old Salt/New Salt teams of two. Team assignments will be available at check in.
- 2.5 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form through the event website

### 3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fees are \$50 for Old Salt and \$25 for New Salt. Any additional donations may be made to the [George Haynie Memorial Fund](#) dedicated to Davis Island Youth Sailing.

### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by 1900 on May 7, 2021.

### 5 VENUE

All classes will race on Hillsborough Bay south of the Davis Island Yacht Club. Viewing will be on the DIYC deck and South lawn.

### 7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race for a class or fleet must be completed to constitute a regatta.

7.2 Competitors will race in the same start; scores will be grouped by Old Salt, New Salt, and ultimately by Old Salt/New Salt team combined results for overall awards.
