Notice of Race (NoR)

Preamble

The Notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 [NP] Federal, state and local rules regarding COVID-19 guidance.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available in the main office of NBYC after May 1th, 2021.

3. COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The official Notice Board is located on the racing bulletin board next to the commodores parking.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a working VHF radio.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on the VHF channel designated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 3.4 Emergency communication channels are VHF 16 for the Harbor Master, and New Bedford Yacht Club monitors VHF channel 68
- 3.5 [DP] While racing, from the first warning signal till the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that are not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 NBYC sonars will be available for members of NBYC
- 4.2 Other classes may be added at the discretion of the OA.
- 4.3 Sonars are available on a first-come-first served basis.
- 4.4 Boats may be reserved by calling the NBYC main office.
- 4.5 At least 3 boats must be reserved by 1500 the day of the event in order to race that day.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$20

6. CREW LIMITATIONS

6.1 Boats must have at least two competitors aboard, (one skipper and one crew).

7. ADVERTISING

7.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

8. SCHEDULE

8.1 Skippers meeting and boat assignments under the tent at 1700hr every Tuesday.

9. VENUE

9.1 Racing will take place in the vicinity of the rock and the buoy.

9.2 NOR Addendum A shows the location of the rock and buoy.

10. COURSES

10.1 The courses will be windward / leeward courses with drop marks.

10.2 The rounding marks will be announced at the skippers meeting.

10.3 Starting and finishing marks will be orange balls.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 Appendix V1 will apply.

12. SCORING

12.1 If 5 races or more are completed, then a competitor's worst score shall be excluded.

12.2 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

13. PRIZES

13.1 Daily first place prizes will be awarded after racing as allowed by COVID regulations

13.2 The OA may decide to award other prizes as they seem fit.
