1) Rules

1.1) RULES: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024), these Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race.

2) Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1) All boats must conform to their Class Measurement Certificate.
- 2.2) Registration may be completed on Regatta Network

3) Notices to Competitors

3.1) Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board on Regatta Network.

4) Changes in Sailing Instructions

4.1) Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1000 hours on the day it will take effect.

5) Signals Made Ashore

5.1) Signals made ashore will be displayed on the KHYC flagpole located on the East patio of the clubhouse. If the postponement signal (AP) is displayed the warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after the AP is lowered.

6) Schedule of Races

- 6.1) Five races are scheduled
- 6.2) 1 race constitutes a regatta
- 6.3) First warning at 1200 hours
- 6.4) No race will be started after 1630

7) Class flag

7.1) Class flag will be the "F" flag

8) The Race Course

8.1) Race course as per Attachment "A"

9) Marks

9.1) Marks are yellow spar buoys or in the approximate positions defined on KHYC Course Chart 2020.

10) The Start

- 10.1) The Committee will attempt to keep all start & restart times at five-minute clock intervals.
- 10.2) The starting line will be in the area of "S" mark.

11) Safety (Category and Crew)

- 11.1) All boats must check in with the Race Committee on the water prior to the first warning signal.
- 11.2) A boat retiring **MUST** notify the committee ASAP. The RC monitors VHF Ch.78.

12) The Finish

- 12.1) The finish line will be the same as the start line.
- 12.2) The Start/Finish line is not restricted.

13) Penalty System

13.1) The "Two Turn Penalty" is replaced with a "One Turn Penalty"; modifying Rules 44.1 & 44.2 Rule 44.3 shall not apply.by

14) Time limit

14.1) Boats failing to start within four minutes after their start signal shall be scored DNS.

15) Protests

- 15.1) Protests shall be written on forms available at the club and delivered to the Race Chairman, Event Leader or PRO within 45 minutes after the race committee boat docks.
- 15.2) The Committee will sound one signal and post docking time on the Official Notice Board.
- 15.3) Protests will be posted as they are submitted.
- 15.4) Protests will be heard in the approximate order of receipt as soon as possible.

16) Scoring

16.1) The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.

17) Prizes

17.1) Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after the event.
