



# PJYC Tuesday Night Race Series

Spring & Summer 2021

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. This event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current edition of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* ("RRS") including *US Sailing Prescriptions*.
- 1.2. **Rule Change:** The Finishing Line is changed to use an Orange flag on the Committee Boat as that end of the line. This changes RRS "Race Signals"/"Other Signals" in the flag section at the end.

### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The online official Notice Board is at: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22429> . See the 'Newsroom & Results' tab for notices, race status (Abandoned, postponed, etc...).
- 3.2. All boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 16 and 72.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on channel 72. However, the standard RRS Sound and Visual signals will be the official signals as usual.
- 3.4. Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data communication related to the race that is not available to all boats.

#### **4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

**4.1.** This event is open to all single hull, non-foiling boats holding a valid PHRF certificate issued by the *Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound* (YRALIS) (<https://www.yralis.org/>). You can get a single event PHRF certificate from YRALIS if needed. Boats without certificates can get a provisional rating from the race committee and will race non-spin only.

**4.2.** No Club Affiliation is required.

**4.3.** Eligible boats shall enter by registering online. Entries must be received no later than May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 for the Spring Series, and July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 for the Summer Series. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Fleet Captain.

#### **5. FEES**

Fees are: \$55 per series (Spring and Summer). Payable by credit card at time of registration.

#### **6. SCHEDULE**

One Race per Day with first division warning at 1900.

**Spring Series:** Every Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup> thru and including July 13<sup>th</sup>. 7 Races total.

**Summer Series:** Every Tuesday, July 20<sup>th</sup> thru and including August 31<sup>st</sup>. 7 Races total.

#### **7. VENUE**

The Racing Area is approximately 1.25 nm NE of the Port Jefferson Harbour East Breakwater. See the *Sailing Instructions*.

#### **8. DIVISIONS**

The fleet will be divided into Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker divisions. Other 'One Design' divisions will be created as the makeup of the fleet allows. Scratch Sheets will be available online at:

#### **9. THE COURSES**

Courses will be signaled from the Committee Boat in accordance with the *Sailing Instructions*.

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1. All divisions will use YRALIS PHRF ratings and will be scored Time-On-Distance.
- 10.2. Scoring will use the 'Low Point' system as described in the RRS Rule 90.3 and RRS Appendix A.
- 10.3. At least 3 of the normally scheduled races as specified in the SCHEDULE section must be held to constitute a Series (Spring or Summer). A race is completed when at least one competitor *finishes* within the time limit specified in the *Sailing Instructions* and is in good standing.
- 10.4. The Series will consist of the races described in the SCHEDULE section of this NOTICE OF RACE.
- 10.5. To be scored in either the Spring or Summer series, a competitor must compete in at least 50% of the completed races for that series. The worst half of the races, rounded down, are discounted (3 out of 7 for example would be thrown out). This modifies RRS Appendix A Section 2 . Also see RRS 90.3
- 10.6. To be scored for the season overall (Spring and Summer series combined), a competitor must compete in at least 50% of the completed races for the season. 50% of the competitor's highest scores will determine the result, as with an individual series.

## 11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after this event.

## 12. PRIZES

- 12.1. Results will be announced after each race back in the PJYC Club House. Daily first prize will be handed out for the winner of each division for that night.
