MANDATORY COMPETITOR CHECK-IN GUIDELINES

Location: Downstairs Race Room

Times: Friday 1400-1700 and Saturday 0800-1000

What we will confirm/check:

- o Sail Number
- o Competitor Fees paid
- Support Person Fees paid \$20 per person. This provides for dinner and 1 drink on Saturday and Sunday awards appetizers upstairs at the RYC Clubhouse. Ideally this is completed online by registering on RegattaNetwork in advance. Please note that RYC's bar & galley are cashless.
- Minor Waiver completed
- o COVID CHECK for Competitor and each Support Person
- Coach Boat: If you will have a support boat on the water, we would like them to check-in with the PRO (Robin Van Vliet – mobile 415.233.0365) and monitor our race VHF channel.

Sail Number Changes: Please update Regatta Network before Thursday or at Check-in with the sail number you intend to use for the weekend. After Check-in is closed, any change to your sail number must be posted on the Race Bulletin Board prior to 0945 each day, otherwise you will be scored DNC.

COVID CHECK INFORMATION

Richmond Yacht Club's Board of Directors has determined that requiring proof of full vaccination by competitors and support persons is the best way to ensure the safety of all participants, volunteers, club members, and staff during the regatta, while on the water and ashore. Vaccination will not be required for competitors below the current minimum vaccination age of 12 and will not be required for their attending family members below that minimum age.

All other competitors, support persons, and attending family members will need to present one of the following during CHECK-IN.

1. **Proof of full vaccination.** A photo, PDF, or other electronic verification of a COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card issued by the CDC and completed by the vaccinating healthcare provider will be sufficient.

2. **Proof of a medical condition** that prohibits COVID-19 vaccination. A photo, PDF, or other electronic verification of a signed statement from a licensed medical professional will be sufficient.

3. **Proof of a religious belief that prohibits COVID-19 vaccination**. A photo, PDF, or other electronic verification of an official paper showing membership in a religious organization with a doctrinal vaccination prohibition will be sufficient.

Those who submit proof of medical condition or religious belief will be required, for their own protection, to wear masks and maintain physical distance during the event when inside the clubhouse or using its rest rooms.
