NOTICE OF RACE D.J.JOHNSON AROUND OAHU REGATTA

May 29th, 30th & 31st, 2021

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
 - 1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
 - 1.2.4. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
- 2. **ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. All yachts must meet the current ISAF cat 4 safety regulations. Eligible boats are required to register through regatta network. Please refer to the website below for entry:

- 4. **CLASSES:** Boats will be scored in PH X, A & B, Cruising & Multihull.
- **5. FEES:** The entry fees will be \$0.00.

- 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network
- VENUE: The waters around the island of Oahu.
- **9. COURCES:** Day 1 Waikiki to Kaneohe

Day 2 – Kaneohe to Haleiwa Day 3 – Pokai Bay to Waikiki

More detailed course information will be in the sailing instructions.

10. SCORING: RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.

11. MOORING:

Day 1 –Kaneohe Bay- Kaneohe Yacht Club will attempt to accommodate as many boats as possible. We will contact you after your entry to update you on mooring options at KYC for your vessel. Some boats may opt to moor at the Sandbar or elsewhere in Kaneohe Bay, which is at their discretion.

Day 2 – Finish in Haleiwa- Haleiwa Harbor has the ability to accommodate smaller vessels on the North Shore in the State Harbor. Otherwise yachts may opt to anchor in Waimea Bay or elsewhere nearby. Some may circle around to the West side where there are anchorages in Makua, Pokai Bay and others. Ko Olina Harbor is not currently accepting mooring requests.

Day 3- Waikiki- Waikiki Yacht Club will have mooring available for entrants whom may dock elsewhere on the island such as Kaneohe Bay or Keehi Lagoon.
