3. REGISTRATION INFO

3.1 At the Skipper's Meeting each Skipper must provide ages of each member of their crew, their Relationship (married or not married), if married, the length of time married, and the number of races competed in prior to this race. Information used solely to determine prizes to be awarded.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 Date of racing: **July 31, Saturday**

Two races are planned but may be limited to one based upon the desires of the Couples.
Scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the day is 1155.

6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 Class flags will be:

PHRF	Pink
One Design	Purple

8. THE COURSES

8.1 The PHRF and One Design courses to be sailed may be windward/leeward (L) or (TL) using dropped marks or designated government marks.

9. MARKS

9.1 The starting marks will be a red tetrahedron and an orange flag on the signal vessel.

9.2 the finish marks will be a red tetrahedron and a blue flag on the signal vessel.

9.3 For the PHRF and One Design windward/leeward (L) or (TL) courses, Mark 1 (windward) and Mark 2 (leeward) will be orange tetrahedrons. Replacement marks will be yellow tetrahedrons. Course Diagram (L) is changed to replace Leeward Marks 2s and 2p with a single Leeward Mark 2. **This changes RRS Appendix S Course Diagrams (L)**

9.4. For a designated government mark course, government marks will be displayed on the stern of the signal vessel.

15. TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

15.1 Time limits and target times are as follows:

Mark 1	45 minutes – Time limit for the first boat to pass Mark 1.
Race Time Limit	2½ hours – Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish.
Finishing Window	55 minutes – Time limit for boats to finish after the first boat in the class sails the course and finishes.

15.2 If no boat has passed Mark 1 within the Mark 1 time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

15.3 If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the race time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

15.4 Boats failing to finish within the finishing window shall be scored DNF (did not finish) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4, and A5.

17. SCORING

17.1 Scoring for the regatta will be based on the boats' adjusted PHRF ratings.

17.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series for the regatta.

21. PRIZES

21.1 Trophy Presentations will be at Pensacola Yacht Club following the final scores.

21.2 Trophies for each division will be awarded for the regatta based on adjusted handicaps as follows:

5 or more boats: 1st – 3rd place.

4 boats: 1st – 2nd place.

3 boats: 1st place.

21.3 Prizes in addition to the above prizes will be awarded as follows:

Prize for the Oldest couple (combined ages) sailing

Prize for the Youngest couple (combined ages) Sailing

Prize for Couple with the least racing experience; having only raced one time.

Prize for Couple with the most racing experience; having won at least 5 races.

Prize for Couple married the longest of all married couples competing.

Prize for Couple finishing last.
