## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 will not apply. RRS 81 will not apply.

## 2 NOTICES

The official notice board is at [dryc.org](http://dryc.org). At DRYC's Catalina Island facility (Schultz's Landing), a notice board will be on the raised deck, near the galley.

## 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 This series is open to boats with current, valid PHRF of So. California ratings.
- 3.2 Classes will be established in 2 divisions, PHRF and Cruising.
- 3.3 If the RC deems an entry unsuitable for the Cruising Division, it may be moved to the PHRF Division.
- 3.4 The entry fee is \$35 for each race. Entry and payment for both races shall be submitted by 1800 June 11<sup>th</sup>, at [dryc.org](http://dryc.org).

- 4.2 Races 1 will start in the vicinity of Marina del Rey H mark (see ASMBYC Course Chart 17). Race 2 will start in the vicinity of Eagle Rock, near the west end of Catalina Island.

## 5 BERTHING, MOORING, and CAT HARBOR HOSPITALITY

- 5.1 Slips may be available at DRYC. Moorings may also be available at Cat Harbor. - 5.2 Cat Harbor moorings may also be reserved by calling the Catalina Island Company at 310-510-4253.
- 5.3 Schultz's Landing has bathrooms, hot showers, ice and BBQs. The OA will provide water, sodas, beer and Margaritas. Coffee will be available on Sunday morning.
- 5.4 Limited shuttle boat service to/from Schultz's Landing will be provided by DRYC volunteers **until midnight Saturday and Sunday morning until approx. 0930**. The drivers will attempt to monitor VHF channel 68. **PLEASE LIMIT THE NUMBER OF TRIPS TO AND FROM YOUR BOAT BY COMBINING CREW ON EACH TRIP!**

## 6 SCORING

- 6.1 Race #1 will be scored using PHRF Area B RLC ratings. Race #2 will be scored using Area B OWC ratings.
- 6.2 Two (2) races shall be completed to constitute a series. No race score shall be excluded.

## 7 AWARDS

- 7.1 Race and series trophies will be awarded on DRYC's Aft Deck Patio at 1430 Sunday July 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 7.2 PHRF AA boats will have a separate finish line for Race #2 and will not be eligible for Division awards.
