## **NOTICE OF RACE**

Saturday, June 5, 2021



### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The [Racing Rules of Sailing](#)*, except [US Sailing Prescriptions](#) to Rule 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.2 NoR 4.5 and 7.3 modify the RRS.

### **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES**

- 2.1 The sailing instructions and course table will be available by **5:00 PM** on Friday, June 4, 2021, on the online official notice board.
- 2.2 All courses will be windward/leeward.

### **3 COMMUNICATION**

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located [here](#), or through the [CRA](#) website.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio channel 68.
- 3.3 [DP] Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

### **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all members of organizations affiliated with US Sailing.
- 4.2 All eligible boats must enter on-line no later than **10:00 PM on Thursday**, June 3, 2021.
- 4.3 Each boat racing in a PHRF class is required to have a current, valid PHRF certificate or temporary rating issued by [PHRF San Diego](#).
- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.5 [DP] All boats shall have clearly visible sail numbers. Missing, improper, inconsistent, unclear, illegible, or numbers other than those used for check-in, are not permitted and

may result in being scored DNF. RRS 60.2, 63.1, and A5 are modified to add that the RC may disqualify a boat infringing this instruction without a hearing.

- 4.6 Late entries will only be accepted from CRA or CYC members. Late entrants may not check in by radio, but must provide to the RC, in writing, the owner's name, DOB, zip code, email address, phone number, boat name and type, sail number, class, and Buoy rating, to complete their entry. Submission of this information to the RC represents the boat's acceptance of the liability waiver in the registration form and that they agree to be bound by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and by all other rules that govern this event.

## **5 FEES**

- 5.1 \$40 Registration fee. No charge for CRA or CYC members. You are instead encouraged to donate to the SEAL Family Foundation by **texting SEAL to 24365** or go to [SEALFAMILYFOUNDATION.org](http://SEALFAMILYFOUNDATION.org).

## **6 CLASSES AND CLASS PENNANTS**

- 6.1 The following classes will be offered: *Spinnaker, Non-Spin, J-24, Harbor 20, One Design*.
- 6.2 One design classes may be considered, if requested by the Fleet Captain, and if four boats sign up by Wednesday, June 2, 2021, to constitute a class.
- 6.3 Spinnaker class breaks will be determined by the Race Committee based on entries. Official Spinnaker Class assignments for the regatta will be established and posted as an amendment to the NoR on the online regatta event site no later than 1200 Friday, June 4, 2021. Provisional assignments MAY be posted earlier.
- 6.4 [DP] The class numeral pennant must be flown from the backstay of all yachts, or in a prominent manner on the stern, when checking in, while racing, and when finishing. Competitors shall supply their own numeral pennant.
- 6.5 The Organizing Authority retains final authority for a boat's class placement.

## **7 SCHEDULE**

- 7.1 Three races are scheduled for all classes.
- 7.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is **11:55 AM**. The warning signal for the subsequent races will be as soon as possible after the completion of the previous race.
- 7.3 There is a time limit of **5:00 pm** for all racing. This changes RRS 35.

## **8 VENUE**

- 8.1 The racing area will be the South San Diego Bay. For navigation, refer to NOAA Chart #18773, San Diego Bay.
- 8.2 The starting area will be in the vicinity of 0.5 nm west of buoys SD28 and SD30.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 9.1 RRS Appendix T: *Arbitration* and RRS Appendix V: *Alternative Penalties* will apply.

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 10.2 Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores. No score will be excluded.
- 10.3 Boats will be scored using Time-on-Distance.
- 10.4 PHRF "Buoy" ratings will be used as the default for scoring all races and to determine class breaks.

## **11 AWARDS CELEBRATION**

- 11.1 After race events will occur at CYC. Boats are encouraged to raft in Glorietta Bay in

- front of CYC where water shuttles will be provided.
- 11.2 The awards celebration will feature **BBQ pork sliders, \$2 beer, and a band: *Peace Frog!***
  - 11.3 Regatta prizes will be awarded using the listed procedure: one prize in each class of 2 - 4 boats, two for 5 - 7 boats, three for 8 or more, based on the number of starters in the class.
  - 11.4 The Crown Cup Perpetual Trophy will have each class winners' names engraved for perpetuity.

## **12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. The race organizers (CRA & CYC, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or another organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. As a condition of their participation in this regatta, competitors release all claims they may have against CRA and its officers, directors, members, committees and employees for damage to property, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Competitors shall be responsible for damage or injury caused by their breach of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* or applicable governmental rules for the avoidance of collision.

## **13 INSURANCE**

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
