NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority for the 2021 will be:
The Point Loma Yacht Club / (PLYC)

1 RULES

Modified to reflect San Diego County Health directive regarding Recreational Boating

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. This race is an open, non-spinnaker event utilizing San Diego PHRF handicaps.

Boating is currently permitted only with your household members. Only same household crews will be allowed to participate. Racing will be abandoned for non-compliance. All participants must wear PFDs at all times.

Sailboats sailing a similar course should take a conservative tactic to avoid any close quarter maneuvers to minimize collisions or prolonged entanglement.

All competitors shall have a face mask on hand for immediate use. All boats will carry an operational VHF radio.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all members of organizations affiliated with US Sailing. Only sailboats that are capable of self-rescue are allowed. All eligible boats must enter on-line at [Jimmy Rogers Memorial Race : Point Loma Yacht Club \(regattanetwork.com\)](http://regattanetwork.com) no later than 1200 on Saturday, June 5, 2020. Late entries will not be accepted.

Boats complete their registration with radio check-in (VHF 68).

3 FEES

3.1 \$20 fee for all entries who are not members of Point Loma Yacht Club.

3.2 There is no fee for members of Point Loma Yacht Club.

4 CLASS BREAKS AND CLASS PENNANTS

Schedule, Class Flags, Classes and Starting Order One race is scheduled. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first class is 1155. Competitors are asked to fly a flag or pennant that identifies them as racers, such as a Club Burgee or a colored streamer. The classes are non-spinnaker and in starting order are as follows: All Racers will Start at the same time at 12 Noon.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Will be posted on Regatta Network.

6 VENUE AND COURSE\

The race will take commence in the Shelter Island area and extend out pass the bay entrance. It will commence North of Buoy 19 in conjunction with the **RC Boat** as appropriate and the course will be directly to SD1 rounding SD1 to Port and return to the finish/start line. **Course Length 12.2 NM**

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1 For all classes, the first two sentences of Rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing or rule 31. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'

7.2 Appendix T2 Penalties Taken After a Race will apply.

7.3 Appendix T5 Protest Arbitration will apply.

8 SCORING

This race will be scored using RLC and San Diego PHRF handicaps and Time Over Distance (TOD).

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile devices.

10 PRIZES

10.1 Race results will be announced and published on Regatta Network

10.2 Race prizes will be awarded at the using a limited process in each class as determined by the Race Committee. See # 8.

11 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. The race organizers (PLYC, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or another organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. As a condition of their participation in this regatta, competitors release all claims they may have against PLYC and its officers, directors, members, committees and employees for damage to property, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Competitors shall be responsible for damage or injury caused by their breach of The Racing Rules of Sailing or applicable governmental rules for the avoidance of collision.

12 POST RACE ACTIVITIES

There will be an after-race activity at Point Loma Yacht Club, 5000 North Harbor Blvd Suite 205, San Diego CA 92106 at approximately 3 PM following the finish of the race.
