NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the A-Class catamaran, Albacore, Flying Scot, Chesapeake 20, and Laser (full and radial will be scored together unless fleet size permits) classes.

3 ENTRY

- 3.1 Registration must be completed online at the event's Regatta Network web site.

- 3.2 Paper entries are not acceptable.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Registration Type	Fee
Single Handed boats	\$35
Double Handed boats	\$50
non-US Sailing member additional fee	\$5

Cancellation prior to the close of onsite registration will be refunded, minus a 10% fee.

5 FOOD AND BEVERAGES

- 5.1 No food or beverage service is planned.

- 6.1 WRSC has beach and crane launching available for use.

8 SCHEDULE

8.1 Saturday

0915 Registration closed
0930 Competitors' meeting (at flagpole or inside if raining)

First Warning Signal:
1100 First warning signal

The Race Committee (RC) will announce the order of starts for the first race at the competitors' meeting.

8.2 Sunday

1030 First warning signal
1500 No races will start after this time

8.3 Number of Races:

There is no limit to the number of races. The committee will attempt to maximize racing for the conditions available.

9 PRIZES

9.1 For each class, prizes will be given to the first-place finisher in classes with three or fewer entries, the first two finishers in classes with six or fewer entries, and the first three finishers in classes with seven or more entries. Prizes for the A-Cat class will be awarded for Foiling and Classic boats as separate classes. Prizes will be mailed or available for pick up at the club when they arrive after the event.

9.2 The Dave Irey Memorial perpetual trophy will be awarded to first place finisher in the class with the largest number of registered competitors.

10 COURSES

10.1 Courses will be set around racing marks as declared in the Sailing Instructions.

11 MEASUREMENTS

11.1 Each boat must satisfy the requirements of its class rules.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 For the Multihull classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.
