The Sequim Bay Yacht Club invites all Thistle, Flying Scot, Lightning, 505, and other small centerboard sailors to the 2021 Sequim Bay Regatta at the John Wayne Marina in Sequim, Washington.

Rules: The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, except as modified by Individual Class rules, the Sailing Instructions or the Appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to Thistle Class sailboats, Flying Scot Class sailboats, Lightning Class sailboats, 505 Class Sailboats, and other small centerboard boats. Boats must conform to class crew, weight, rigging, and equipment rules.

Scoring: Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A, Low Point Scoring System. No score will be excluded.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 boats and crews in each class.

Launching & Boat Storage: Launching will be available at the John Wayne Marina. Please note the marina is paid a separate launch fee by boat owners. Boats may be stored overnight at the marina. For campers staying at the Sequim Bay State Park, launching and boat storage is available there and is strongly encouraged.

Accommodations: Camp sites are available adjacent to the marina at the John Wayne Waterfront Resort. Campsites are \$35 per night. The camping area also has showers and a small store. <u>Call 360-681-3853</u> to make reservations and mention you are with the Sequim Bay Regatta. Saturday Dinner: Unless otherwise restricted by Covid 19 mandates, the SBYC will host dinner at the clubhouse after racing on Saturday. Cost is \$8 and includes burgers or hot dogs and sides. Please let us know if you would like a vegetarian option. The club bar will be open for no-host beverages. Racers and guests are urged to pre-purchase dinners so that we can estimate numbers. If unforeseen conditions make the dinner not possible, money will be returned.
