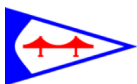

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

(Note: per the RRS 2021-24 the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs) should not repeat what's in the NOR. Please refer to the NOR and SIs for information on this event.)

1 NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- 1.1 The Online Official Notice Board (ONB) is located at:
<https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22625>
- 1.2 Race Committee will use VHF 71 for all communications on the water including changes to the SIs and courses to be raced.

2 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Any change to the sailing instructions prior to the day of racing will be posted on the (ONB) before 8:00 hrs the day of racing.

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: All signals will be made from the shore breakwater adjacent to Golden Gate YC. No signal boat.

4 FLAGS: Course flags will not be used. VHF 71 will announce courses before the 1st warning signal of each race. The Class Flag will be J-Flag (JULIET).

5 RESTRICTED AREAS: For safety reasons boats shall not cross the following lines bounded by the points below and the closest points ashore:

- Anita Rock "AR" and Buoy (if in position NW of Anita Rock).
- The "H" Beam (located approximately 200 yards W of StFYC).
- The Green Bell Buoy "AZ" off the NW end of Alcatraz Island.
- The Green Bell Buoy "3" off Point Blunt on Angel Island.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 One practice start is planned followed by three races.
- 6.2 **11:00 hrs Practice start warning signal.**
- 6.3 **11:15 hrs First warning for first of three races planned.**

7 STARTING: The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the breakwater in the vicinity of Golden Gate YC and "X" buoy in front of GGYC.

8 FINISH

- 8.1 The finish line will be between the flagpole at GGYC and the X Buoy.
- 8.2 Boats shall note their finish time and the name of the boat ahead and behind them. Text this information to the PRO (contact info at end of this document).
- 8.3 Boats retiring before finishing shall notify the PRO via text or cell and announce via VHF 71.
- 8.4 Finish results may be available shortly after the last boat finishes on the (ONB).

9 TIME LIMIT: No warning after 16:00 hrs.

10 PROTESTS: Protests shall be texted or emailed to the PRO by midnight 6/12/21. Protest hearings will be scheduled via ZOOM asap. A list of protests, hearing dates, times and decisions will be posted on the (ONB).

11 INTERFERENCE WITH OTHER VESSELS: Boats shall not impede the passage of a vessel that can safely navigate only within a narrow channel, fairway or large-vessel traffic lane.

13 DESCRIPTION of YRA MARKS	
6	Lighted Yellow Column "KKN1" 200 yds. N of Ft. Mason docks
8	YRA Mark "8", R "4" Fl 4s Horn 1 nm east of Pt. Blunt
12	G "1" Fl G4s Little Harding Rock
16	YRA Mark "16", Yellow Column "C" 0.2 nm east of Fort Point "Blackaller" OR an inflatable mark if 16 is missing.
18	RG "BR" Fl (2+1) G6s Bell - Blossom Rock
X	Yellow mark approx 100 yards due north of Golden Gate YC
