

# Kelowna Yacht Club (KYC) Open Racing 2021 Dick Duggan Series and Fall Fringe Series

### **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)**

### 1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024)*, the prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Notice of Race (NoR) for these series, the Sailing Instructions for these series, and the Santana 525 class rules where they apply.

#### 2 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than one (1) hour before racing on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 8:00 PM on the day before it will take effect.
- 2.2 Changes to a sailing instruction may be made on the water by displaying the Come Within Hail flag and announcing changes on VHF Radio Channel 72.

#### 3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the north end of B dock beside the ramp connecting the dock to shore.
- 3.2 The race office is located at KYC Statistician's Office, telephone 250-490-5689, email petty.john.douglas@gmail.com.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 72.
- 3.4 The following communications may be made by the race committee on VHF channel 72.
  - Changes to course
  - Requirement for individuals on a boat to wear life jackets
  - Changes to SIs

### 4 CODE OF CONDUCT

- 4.1 [Discretionary Penalty DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.
- 4.2 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall handle any equipment by the organizing authority with care, seamanship, in accordance with any instructions for its use and without interfering with its functionality.

#### 5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the KYC Flagpole.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

### **6** SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 See SI Addendum A for Schedule table
- 6.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for Sunday races is 12:00 PM.

  The scheduled time of the warning signal for Wednesday races is 6:00 PM.
- No warning signal will be made after 1:00 PM on Sundays.No warning signal will be made after 7:00 PM on Wednesdays.
- 6.4 Races will be started as described in RRS 26, except that an Attention signal, consisting of a series of sounds, may be made one minute before the first warning signal.

### 7 CLASS FLAGS

7.1 Fleet 1 Class flag is the Numeral pendant 1. The Santana 525 Class flag is the Numeral pendant 2. Fleet 3 Class flag is the Numeral pendant 3.

#### 8 RACING AREA

8.1 SI Addendum B shows the location of the racing area.

### 9 COURSES

- 9.1 The table in SI Addendum C shows the courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed. All marks to be left to port.
- 9.2 No later than the warning signal, the race committee signal vessel will display the course number to be raced. Course 42 will be displayed if the RoD has determined that a custom course is to be raced, in which case the race committee signal vessel will also display the course.

#### 10 MARKS

10.1 The following marks can be rounding marks: A, B, C, D, and E.

#### 11 THE START

- 11.1 The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel and mark X.
- 11.2 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races.
- 11.3 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.

#### 12 THE FINISH

- 12.1 The finishing line is between the orange flag mounted to the signal boat and the course side of Mark X. This changes RRS Race Signals Blue Flag
- 12.2 If the race committee is absent when a boat finishes, she shall report her finishing time, and her position in relation to nearby boats, to the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

#### 13 TIME LIMITS

13.1 The Mark 1 Time Limit, and the Race Time Limit (see RRS 35) are shown in the table below.

| Mark 1 Time | Sunday Race | Wednesday Race |  |
|-------------|-------------|----------------|--|
| Limit       | Time Limit  | Time Limit     |  |
| 45 Mins     | 3 Hrs       | 2 hrs          |  |

13.2 If no boat has passed the first mark within the Mark 1 Time Limit, the race will be abandoned.

### 14 HEARING REQUESTS

- 14.1 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat finishes the last race of the day.
- 14.2 Hearing request forms are available from the race office at Statisticians Office.
- 14.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the protest room, located at the board room, beginning at the time posted.
- 14.4 RRS 62.2(a) and 66.2(a) do not apply.

#### 15 SCORING

- 15.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 15.2 See NoR for details on scoring system.
- 15.3 Rule A5.3 applies.

#### 16 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 16.1 All Transport Canada safety regulations as they apply.
- 16.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 16.3 A boat may be requested to assist another vessel as directed by the Race Officer of the Day.

### 17 EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

- 17.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules, Notice of Race, and Sailing Instructions.
- 17.2 [DP] When instructed by a race official on the water, a boat shall proceed to a designated area for inspection.

#### 18 TRASH DISPOSAL

18.1 Trash must be taken ashore and disposed of in the provided containers. It is not permissible for a boat to discharge any trash into the lake.

#### 19 PRIZES

19.1 Prizes will be given in each class for first, second, and third place.

### 20 RISK STATEMENT

20.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury.

Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.

#### 21 INSURANCE


21.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
