SBYC Adult Racing Camp August 13, 2021 Notice of Event



Organizing and Hosting Authority ("OA"): Spray Beach Yacht Club, NJ, USA

ABOUT THE CAMP: Would you like to cram a season's worth of racing starts and mark rounding's into a single day event? Want to improve your boat handling and perfect your tacks and gybes? Want to overcome your racing anxiety and get out there with your friends. Would you like to meet a group of competitive, friendly sailors, have the chance to try different settings, trims, setups, techniques, and strategies, and learn how it affects the boat. Do you want "to become one" with your boat, to gain confidence, boat handling skills, and racing experience?

Based on the Rick White style sailing seminar, participants will experience a fun and educational racing environment through short sailing drills. On the water drills during the day are followed by video playback, critique, and discussion. Sailors will share their camp experiences, successes, failures, and techniques in a friendly and affable setting.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all Hobie Waves or Sunfishes. This is a bring your own boat event. The OA has no role or responsibility of chartering boats. Entry shall be made by completing the entry form available at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22684. Cost is \$30.00 per boat. Enrollment is capped at 25 boats. This is a bring-your-own-water-bottle-event.

EVENT DETAILS: Check-in and Registration starts at 8:00 AM Friday, Aug. 13th, 2021. The course will start with a chalk talk on the drills, then move to land based basic rigging, then to on the water drills. After the drills and returning to land we will debrief with videos. We plan to supply breakfast, lunch and dinner and be done by 6:00 PM. Depending on the wind and weather the schedule may be adjusted accordingly.

VENUE: Spray Beach Yacht Club, 23rd and Bay Blvd, Long Beach Island, New Jersey. This event shall be held just preceding the Spray Beach YC Division 11 annual Hobie regatta on August 14-15, 2021.

INSURANCE: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent thereof. Proof of liability insurance may be required at the time of registration (online or in person). USCG approved PFD's are required to be correctly worn at all times while participating on the water in the Sailing Camp.

ACCOMODATIONS: Boats and trailers should be staged at the north end of the club.

RISK STATEMENT: By participating in this event each sailor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes."
