NOTICE OF RACE 2021 KALAKAUA CUP REGATTA

Sunday, July 4th, 2021

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing will apply, except that the US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 and 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.3 RRS No. 47 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
- 1.4 **WORLD SAILING OFFSHORE SPECIAL REGULATIONS** (for 2020-2021) SECTION 2 – APPLICATION & GENERAL REQUIREMENTS 2.01.6 Special Regulations will apply (See Appendix B - Short races, close to shore in relatively warm or protected waters normally held in daylight).
- 1.5 Advertising will not be restricted.
- 1.6 All boats shall carry an operating VHF radio. Channel 68 will be used.
- 1.7 Kaneohe Yacht Club (KYC) is the organizing authority.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, and FEES: The races are open to monohull keel boats owned or chartered by members of HYRA clubs possessing a valid HYRA PHRF handicap. Other boats may be invited by the organizing authority.

- 2.1 Eligible boats are encouraged to register using Regatta Network prior to 1830 Saturday, July 3rd.

- 2.2 Eligible boats may also enter by completing the entry form and submitting it with the required fee to KYC by the skipper's meeting. The entry fee for the July 4th event is \$75.00 (or \$70.00 for US Sailing members).

3. CLASSES: Classes X, A, B and Aloha as defined by HYRA. A Minimum of three (3) entries by 1830 on Saturday, July 3rd will be required to establish a class.

4. SCHEDULE of EVENTS:

- 4.1 Skippers' Meetings – 1730 Thursday, July 1st at Kaneohe Yacht Club, Upper Deck.
- 4.2 Starting Time: The first of three 'Kaneohe Offshore' races will begin Sunday, July 4th at 1100, with a warning signal at 1055. The warning signal for Kaneohe Offshore Race 2 & 3 will be shortly after the last boat finishes Race 1.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available on Regatta Network and at Kaneohe Yacht Club after **June 18th**.

6. VENUE and COURSES: The courses will be on the coastal waters of Oahu. Refer to the Sailing Instructions for each day's race.

7. SCORING:

7.1 Results from the **Kaneohe Offshore** races on July 4th will be used to determine the winner of the Kalakaua Cup.

7.2 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4 will apply, except that no race scores will be excluded. This modifies Rule A2.

7.3 Only the Kalakaua Cup on July 4th will be used in HYRA Oahu Season's Points Scoring.

8. BERTHING: For visiting boats, contact the KYC Port Captain, Kyle Morton, at kyle@kaneoheyachtclub.com or 808-650-4192 at least one week prior to arrival at KYC to discuss mooring arrangements. To facilitate mooring arrangements at KYC, visiting boats must provide LOA, beam and draft data to the KYC Port Captain.

9. PRIZES: The Kalakaua Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the overall PHRF winner of the **Kaneohe Offshore** races on July 4th This will also be officially presented at the 2021 HYRA Annual Awards Dinner.
