NOTICE OF RACE

1. BACKGROUND

1.1. The Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club PHRF Fall Series are held annually. The traditional Summer Series has been integrated into the Spring and Fall series, or replaced with races that form part of the Monterey Bay Yacht Racing Association Championship series.

2. RULES

2.1. The PHRF series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.

3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats owned by MPYC members.
- 3.2. Entries shall be made online, using the MPYC Regatta Network portal at MPYC Race Registration Packet

4. BOATS

4.1. The regatta will be sailed in boats with valid 2021 PHRF ratings issued by the Monterey Bay PHRF Committee.

5. **SCHEDULE**

- 5.1. The PHRF Fall Series schedule is published in the 2021 MPYC Race Calendar available at www.MPYC.org.
 - 5.1.1.The David Duncan Memorial Race will serve as the PHRF Fall 4 race.

6. **FEES**

- 6.1. Entry fees are specified in the MPYC Regatta Network race registration portal.
- 6.2. Entry fees for the MPYC David Duncan Memorial/PHRF Fall 4 race are included in the MPYC PHRF race registration fee.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The 2021 Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club Sailing Instructions will apply. Additional sailing instructions, if required will be published at www.MPYC.org.

8. **COURSES**

- 8.1. The courses are listed in the 2021 MPYC Course list available at www.MPYC.org, or as posted by the race committee on the MPYC Race Committee boat.
- 8.2. The starting area will be in the vicinity of the MPYC Race Committee Boat.

9. **SCORING**

- 9.1. Scoring of all MPYC races will be in accordance with the 2021 MPYC Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2. The Spring and Fall PHRF series fleet winners and the overall PHRF Championship per fleet shall be awarded based on the total number of places scored during each series and the overall season.

10. PRIZES

10.1. The Race Chairperson, in consultation with the Fleet Captains, will determine trophies for the PHRF Spring & Fall Series. Generally, trophies are awarded for first, second and third place finishers in each class for each series; except for a class with less than 5 entries, which may be awarded trophies for only first or only first and second place finishers at the discretion of the Race Chairperson.

11. **DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY**

11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
